### PC-DW-1 PARMA COUNCIL OF PTAS - GERANIUM SCHOLARSHIPS

Two grants per high school \$1,400 each

(2 at Valley Forge, 2 at Normandy and 2 students that attended Parma Sr. High and currently attend either Valley Forge or Normandy)

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior of a Parma public high school.
- 2. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not graduate high school (or attain the equivalent) or does not begin higher education within 12 months of receiving the scholarship.
- 3. Recipient is responsible to supply proof of completion of one year of College, University or Technical School within 18 months of beginning higher education.

## PC-DW-2 PARMA COUNCIL OF PTAS - GERANIUM CAREER & TECHNICAL SCHOLARSHIP One grant per district \$1,400

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior of a Parma public high school.
- 2. The applicant must have completed a two-year Career and Technical Track program through the Parma Public Schools.
- 3. The applicant must enroll in supplemental training, which will advance their education in their field.
- 4. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not graduate high school (or attain the equivalent) or does not begin higher education within 12 months of receiving the scholarship.
- 5. Recipient is responsible to supply proof of completion of one year of college, university, technical, or vocational school within 18 months of beginning higher education.

## PC-DW-3 PARMA COUNCIL OF PTAS-GERANIUM ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP One grant per district \$1,400

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior of a Parma public high school who is currently enrolled in a special education program with an IEP (Individual Education Plan) on record for at least two years. (The only exception is a student residing in the school district who may be serviced through another school district due to program availability.)
- 2. The applicant must be planning to attend a technical school, an apprenticeship or college.
- 3. The recipient is responsible to supply proof of completion of one year of college, university or technical school within 18 months of beginning higher education.
- 4. Teacher, administrator or counselor recommendation must be included.

### PC-DW-4 PARMA COUNCIL OF PTAS COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP

### Four Grants (two VF, two NHS) minimum \$500 each

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior of the Parma City School District.
- 2. The applicant must have a GPA of 3.0
- 3. The applicant must be seeking higher education from a two or four year college, university or technical school.
- 4. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not begin higher education within 12 months of receiving the scholarship.

## PEC-DW-1 PARMA EARLY CHILDHOOD SARAH KYKER PTA SCHOLARSHIP One grant \$700

- 1. Applicants must be a graduating senior of a Parma City School District public high school.
- 2. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not graduate high school or does not begin higher education within 12 months of receiving the scholarship.
- 3. Recipient is responsible to supply proof of completion of one year of college, university, or technical school within 18 months of beginning higher education.
- 4. Community service and community involvement in the Parma area will be taken into consideration for this award.

### PEC-DW-2 FIRST STEP PTA SCHOLARSHIP

### One Grant \$750

- 1. Recipient must have attended First Step Preschool or Daycare for a minimum of one year.
- 2. Must be a graduating senior of PCSD
- 3. Must complete 1 full year at a college/university or complete a trade program or apprenticeship.

### PE-DW-1 DENTZLER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PTA THE GERALDINE FRITCHIE SCHOLARSHIP

### Two Grants \$500 each

- 1. The applicant must have attended Dentzler Elementary school for at least one year (or would have attended Dentzler had their school not been affected due to closure, consolidation or redistricting)
- 2. The applicant must be a graduating senior of a Parma public high school.
- 3. Award is based on a scholarship achievement and character.
- 4. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not begin higher education within 18 months of receiving scholarship.

### PE-DW-2 GREEN VALLEY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PTA SCHOLARSHIP

### One grant \$1,000

- 1. The applicant must have attended Green Valley Elementary School (or have attended a Parma City Schools elementary school in the current Green Valley attendance areas closed as a result of consolidation) for their final three years of elementary school.
- 2. The applicant must be a graduating senior of a Parma public high school.

### PE-DW-3 JOHN MUIR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PTA SCHOLARSHIP

### One grant \$750

- 1. The applicant must have attended John Muir Elementary School for at least three years (or have attended a Parma City Schools elementary school in the current John Muir attendance area that closed as a result of consolidation).
- 2. The applicant must be a graduating senior of a Parma public high school.
- 3. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not attend college or complete at least one year of college.
- 4. The recipient is highly encouraged to submit a mid and end of school year brief educational experience update to the John Muir PTA.

### PE-DW-4 JOHN MUIR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STAFF SCHOLARSHIP

### One grant \$750

- 1. The applicant must have attended John Muir Elementary School for at least three years (or have attended a Parma City Schools elementary school in the current John Muir attendance area that closed as a result of consolidation).
- 2. The applicant must be a graduating senior of a Parma public high school.
- 3. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not attend college or complete at least one year of college.
- 4. The recipient is highly encouraged to submit a mid and end of school year brief educational experience update to the John Muir PTA.

### PE-DW-5 PARMA PARK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PTA -JAY HOLLOWAY AND MAX FEDORCHUK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (TWO STUDENTS WHO PASSED AWAY IN 1997 WITH LEUKEMIA)

### One grant \$750

- 1. The applicant must have attended Parma Park Elementary School
- 2. Applicant is a graduating senior of a Parma public high school.
- 3. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not complete one full year of college.

### PE-DW-6 PLEASANT VALLEY ELEMENTARY PTA SCHOLARSHIP

### Four grants \$500.00 each

- 1. The applicant must be a Parma public high school graduating senior.
- 2. The applicant must have attended Pleasant Valley (or have attended a Parma City Schools elementary school in the current Pleasant Valley attendance area closed or redistricted as a result of consolidation) for their final years of elementary school.
- 3. Following your essay, you have the option to attach a summary of how you were involved or active at your elementary school.
- 4. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not complete one full year of college or applicable post secondary program. (ie- certification)
- 5. The recipient must complete graduation or its equivalent.
- 6. The recipient must attend a college, university or other post secondary institution within 12 months of their graduation year.

### PE-DW-7 RENWOOD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PTA SCHOLARSHIP

### One grant \$500 each

- 1. The applicant must have attended Renwood Elementary School for at least five years
- 2. The applicant should have an accumulative GPA of 3.0 at the time of application.
- 3. The applicant will be judged on his/her scholastic achievement and school/community involvement.
- 4. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not complete the first calendar year of higher education.
- 5. If all our applicants already are getting another scholarship none will be given this year. The reason being we did not have enough in the funds to give to all the years of students who went to just Renwood and wanted as many as possible to get at least 1 scholarship.

### PE-DW-8 RIDGE-BROOK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PTA

### One grant \$750

- 1. The applicant must have attended Ridge-Brook Elementary School for a minimum of two years.
- 2. Applicants must be a graduating senior of a Parma public high school.
- 3. Reimbursement is required if the recipient withdraws from college or institute of higher learning during the first year.

## PE-DW-9 THOREAU PARK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PTA SCHOLARSHIP- THE BARBARA GROVES/DARIN CARLETON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

### One Grant \$500

- 1. The applicant must have attended Thoreau Park Elementary School for at least three years (or would have attended Thoreau Park had their school not been affected due to closure, consolidation or redistricting).
- 2. The applicant must be a graduating senior of a Parma public high school.
- 3. Award is based on scholastic achievement and character.
- 4. Must have a minimum 2.5 grade point average.

### PM-DW-1 GREENBRIAR MIDDLE SCHOOL PTA GRANT One grant \$750

- 1. The scholarship will be awarded to a former Greenbriar Middle School student who:
- 2. Attended Greenbriar Middle School for at least three years.
- 3. Is a graduating senior of a Parma public high school.
- 4. Applicant must achieve a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5
- 5. Reimbursement to the Greenbriar Middle School PTA is required if the student does not complete one full year of college/career/technical school within 3 years.

### PM-DW-2 HILLSIDE MIDDLE SCHOOL PTA SCHOLARSHIP

### One Scholarship \$1000

- 1. The applicant must have attended Hillside Middle School for at least one full year.
- 2. The applicant must be a graduating senior of a Parma public high school.
- 3. Reimbursement is required if the recipient fails to finish the first year of higher education.

### PM-DW-3 SHILOH MIDDLE SCHOOL PTA GRANT

### One grant \$500

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior of Parma City Schools.
- 2. The applicant must have attended Shiloh Middle School for at least two years unless due to redistricting.
- 3. The applicant must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 to apply.
- 4. The recipient must attend a college, university or other post secondary institution within 18 months of their graduation year.

### PH-NHS-1 NORMANDY HIGH SCHOOL PTSA GRANT

### Seven grants \$1000 each

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior of Normandy High School.
- 2. The applicant must have attended a Parma City Schools High School for 3 years,
- 3. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not complete one full year of higher education.

### PH-PSH-2 PARMA SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL PTSA SCHOLARSHIP

### Two grants \$750 each

- 1. The applicant must have attended Parma Senior High School for at least two years.
- 2. The applicant must have an accumulative GPA of 2.0 at the time of the application.
- 3. The applicant will be judged on his/her scholastic achievement and school/community involvement.
- 4. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not complete the first calendar year of higher education.
- 5. Additional consideration will be given to those applicants who are PTSA members.

### PH-VFH-3 VALLEY FORGE HIGH SCHOOL PTSA SCHOLARSHIP

### Two grants \$800

- 1. The applicant must have attended a Parma City Schools High School for at least three years.
- 2. The applicant must be a graduating senior of Valley Forge High School.
- 3. The applicant must attend an institution of higher learning within 12 months of the class' graduation date.
- 4. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not complete one full year of the institution of higher learning.

### **EL-DW-1 KRISTINA SHIRAK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

### One Grant \$1000

- 1. The applicant must have attended a Parma City Schools Elementary School.
- 2. The applicant must be graduating from a Parma City Schools High School.
- 3. The applicant is pursuing a degree in Elementary Education at a College or University.
- 4. The applicant must submit a minimum of one but no more than 3 letters of recommendation from an employer, teacher, coach or adult who can attest to the applicant's character, skills and academic performance.
- 5. Reimbursement is required if the recipient withdraws from the college or university of higher learning during the first year.

### **EL-DW-2 GARDNER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP**

### One grant \$1000

- 1. Applicant must have attended Ridgebrook Elementary School for at least 1 year.
- 2. Applicant must be a senior graduating from Parma City Schools.
- 3. Reimbursement may be required if the recipient withdraws from college or institute of higher learning during the first year.

## SH-NHS-1 NORMANDY HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT GOVERNMENT LEADERSHIP GRANT Two grants \$1,200 each

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior of Normandy High School.
- 2. The applicant must be actively involved in student government for at least 2 years.
- 3. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not attend college.

### SH-NHS-2 THE NORMANDY HIGH SCHOOL FACULTY & STAFF SCHOLARSHIP Minimum of one grant \$500

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior from Normandy High School.
- 2. The applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above.
- 3. The applicant must be planning on attending either a two year or four year college in the year immediately following graduation.
- 4. The applicant must include an essay that addresses the following question/scenario: Describe one instance in your high school career where you became the teacher. Be sure to describe challenges you faced and how you overcame them. OR Write about an experience when you have had to tell the truth when it was not easy to tell the truth.

### SH-PSH-1 Parma Senior High Music Club Scholarship

### Two Grants \$750 (one vocal and one instrumental)

- 1.Minimum of one (1) year of Parma Senior High Band, Choir, and/or Orchestra
- 2.Current Music Student at Valley Forge or Normandy High Schools (2023/2024)
- 3. Planning to attend a College or University in 2024-2025
- 4. Graduating Senior (Spring 2024)
- 5.Minimum GPA of 2.5
- 6.Students must show proof of college attendance during the 2024-2025 school year. If the student does not enroll in college, the scholarship funds must be returned to PSH Music Club.

Students are NOT required to be a future college music major to apply. (Priority will be given to students who plan to continue with Music in College)

## SH-VFH-1 VALLEY FORGE HIGH SCHOOL ADULT ATHLETIC BOOSTERS SCHOLARSHIPS Two (one Female and one Male) \$500 each

- 1. Athletes must be involved in any varsity sport at Valley Forge for one year, one of which must be during junior or senior year.
- 2. GPA of at least cumulative 2.5 average for high school education.
- 3. The applicant must have attended a Parma City Schools High School for at least two years.
- 4. The applicant must be graduating from Valley Forge this year.
- 5. The scholar must attend a school of higher learning.
- 6. The recipient will be responsible for reimbursement if they do not complete one year of higher learning.
- 7. Money will be awarded with proof of enrollment in a school of higher learning.

## SH-VFH-2 VALLEY FORGE HIGH SCHOOL MUSIC BOOSTERS SCHOLARSHIP Three grants \$500

- 1. The applicant must have completed four years of high school music to include choir, orchestra, concert band or marching band (including color guard) with junior and senior years at a Parma City Schools High School.
- 2. The application must be a graduating senior at Valley Forge.
- 3. The applicant shall be enrolled in a post-secondary course of study within 12 months of graduation.

### SH-VFH-3 VALLEY FORGE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT COUNCIL LEADERSHIP GRANT

### Four grants \$1,000 each

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior of Valley Forge High School.
- 2. The applicant must be actively involved in Student Council for at least two years and also have other service to Valley Forge High School.
- 3. The applicant must display leadership ability in school activities.

## SH-VFH-4 VALLEY FORGE HIGH SCHOOL FACULTY & STAFF SCHOLARSHIP At least one grant \$750

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior at Valley Forge High School.
- 2. The applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or above.
- 3. The applicant must be planning on attending either a two or four year college.
- 4. Reimbursement will be required if the recipient does not complete one full year of college.

### SH-VFH-5 VALLEY FORGE FOOTBALL PARENTS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

### Two Grants \$750 each

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior at Valley Forge that plans to attend college or a vocational/trade school.
- 2. The applicant must have participated in football for all four years of school (at any combination PCSD highschool).
- 3. An additional essay that answers the following prompt is required: "In approximately 300 words, describe how football has shaped your character, helping you overcome challenges, build leadership skills, and prepare for your future goals."
- 4. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not attend college or vocational/trade school.

## SH-VFH-6 VALLEY FORGE HIGH SCHOOL NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENT (O.O.C.) SCHOLARSHIP Two grants \$750 each

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior of Valley Forge High School.
- 2. The applicant must be planning on entering a technical school or college for post high school training.
- 3. The applicant must have a record of documented disability (current year IEP) throughout high school.
- 4. The applicant must have a statement of support prepared and signed by the current IEP case manager. This can be a simple hand-written or typed statement saying the student is a good candidate and has college or vocational plans.
- 5. The applicant will be judged by a team of intervention specialists at Valley Forge High School on scholastic and/or vocational achievement, teacher input and completed application.
- 6. Applicant must complete a short statement on his/her career/post high school education plans. This can be hand-written or typed but should give their specific intentions for their educational plans after high school.

- 3. The recipient must complete one year of college in the field of his/her choice.

## C-DW-2 ASSOCIATION OF PARMA ADMINISTRATOR'S SCHOLARSHIP (THIS GRANT HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED TO ENCOURAGE CAPABLE STUDENTS TO ENTER THE TEACHING FIELD.)

### Two grants 1 per HS \$750 each

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior of a Parma public high school.
- 2. The applicant must have achieved an accumulative 3.0 or better grade point average.
- 3. The applicant must have demonstrated leadership ability, satisfactory citizenship and actively participated in extracurricular activities.
- 4. The applicant must be planning to enter the field of EDUCATION.
- 5. The applicant may be enrolled in a 2 or 4 year college.
- 6. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not attend college.

### C-DW-3 PARMA EDUCATION ASSOCIATION MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- Two grants \$750 each
- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior of a Parma public high school.
- 2. The awards are based on scholastic achievement and school/community service.
- 3. The applicant must be planning to enter the EDUCATION field.
- 4. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not attend college.

## C-DW-4 PARMA EDUCATION ASSOCIATION ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP One grant \$500

- 1. The applicant must be planning on either entering a technical school, an apprenticeship program, or college program.
- 2. The applicant must be a special education student in the Parma Public Schools, or a special education student whose parent is a PEA member.

### One grant \$1,000 (possibility of second at \$750)

- 4. The applicant must indicate the Local 160 parent/guardian/grandparent's name and work location on the front page of the application.

- 4. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not begin studies within one year of receipt of the award.

- 3. Reimbursement is required if the recipient does not attend college or technical school within 12 months of graduation.

- 4. Reimbursement is required if the above conditions are not met. Also, reimbursement is required if the recipient does not graduate or does not begin higher education within 6 months of receiving the scholarship.
