College Planning Checklist

- ☑ Identify important factors to you in choosing a college: location, size and type, programs, personal fit, standards of admissions, and cost
- ☑ Register for and take the ACT, SAT, and SAT Subject tests
 - The ACT and & SAT should be taken in the spring of junior year and again in the fall of senior year
 - Check with your schools to see if they require the writing section of the ACT and SAT
 - SAT Subject tests should be taken immediately after a student finishes studying that subject
- ☑ Begin to explore and research career and school options:
 - Utilize the internet in your search
 - Visit college campuses
- ☑ Continue enrichment experiences in the summer such as work, travel, volunteering, research activities or other educational experiences
- ☑ Review your community service
 - If you do no have substantial service experience, start now
 - If you do, take it further

SELECTING A COLLEGE

As colleges are considered, keep the following in mind:

Location: urban, rural, suburban, geographic location, & availability of nearby amenities (recreation, internships, etc.)

<u>Size & Type</u>: size of student body, public institutions, and private institutions

<u>Choice of Programs</u>: specific majors offered or liberal arts programs

<u>Personal Fit</u>: your goals and individual strengths, needs, and passions

<u>Admission</u>: schools which are first, second, & third tier options

Application Strategies

Students are encouraged to apply to at least three schools. To help navigate the application process, students should apply to schools with the tier system in mind.

First Tier (reach for the stars)

Student's test scores, GPA & personal profile do not meet the school's average range, yet the student has a particular interest in the school.

Second Tier (solid match)

Student's test scores, GPA and personal profile match the school's average range.

Third Tier (don't be left out)

Student's test scores, GPA and personal profile exceed the school's average range.
