Enrollment transfer process with Ed Codes and Board Policies

FIRST PRIORITY/ADMITTANCE

District Residents

1. Students whose parents reside in District, including students with disabilities and foster and homeless youth per federal law. Ed Code 35160.5 (b)



SECOND PRIORITY/ADMITTANCE

Discretional Enrollment Priorities per current ed code (still within district residents)

- 1. Is enrolled in a district school designated by the CDE as "persistently dangerous" (20 USC 7912; 5 CCR 11992),
- 2. Is a victim of a violent crime while on school grounds (20 USC 7912), 3. Is a victim of an act of bullying committed by another district student, as determined through an investigation.
- 4. Is experiencing special circumstances that might be harmful or dangerous to the student in the current attendance area,
- 5. Is a sibling of another student already attending that school,
- 6. Has a parent/guardian whose primary place of employment is that school.



THIRD PRIORITY/ADMITTANCE

Admission Process (still within district residents)

- · Must use random and unbiased selection.
- (ex. Legal placements, County placements, suspended expulsion placements)



FOURTH PRIORITY/ADMITTANCE

Allen Bill Interdistrict Transfers (Outside of the district residents)

- School Choice
- *Students for whom at least one parent is physically employed within district boundaries for a minimum of 10 hours during school week
- 2. *Does not have to reapply for district enrollment Education Code 48204(b)
 - Proof/verification of employment in the district is required yearly
 - An Allen Bill Interdistrict Student is guaranteed a spot in a district school with capacity
 - Preferred school/current school placement is not guaranteed, as it is dependent of space
 - Application for a specific school is required any interdistrict transfer students, and any student that resides in the district that misses the regular enrollment window.



FIFTH PRIORITY/ADMITTANCE

Enrollment Priorities (Outside of the district residents)

- 1. None identified by Board policy or law.
- 2. *Must not displace a student currently residing within a school's attendance area



6TH PRIORITY/ADMITTANCE

Admission Process (Outside of the district residents)

1. Must use non-arbitrary criteria.
