Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are writing to inform you of a requirement set forth by the Texas State Board of Education (SBOE) regarding dyslexia and related disorders. In accordance with 19 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §74.28(f), all school districts and open-enrollment charter schools are required to provide information about dyslexia and related disorders to parents of students enrolled in our school.

The rule, 19 TAC §74.28, is detailed in the SBOE's **Dyslexia Handbook**, which can be accessed at the Texas Education Agency's website at tea.texas.gov/dyslexia. The handbook describes the following important information:

- Common characteristics of dyslexia and related disorders
- The evaluation and identification process when dyslexia or a related disorder is suspected
- Instructional requirements for students identified with dyslexia or related disorders
