Comments on Consensus Reports and Presentations

Mr. Lippitt, student ex-officio member, reported on STAP-Comm. He shared the high school came in first place in the Huddle for Hunger. As one of the prizes, 10 STAP-Comm cabinet members attended the Bills Monday Night Football game. This spring, several members of the Buffalo Bills will come to the high school to thank and recognize students for their support. Homecoming was a huge success. - Presentation: District Comprehensive Improvement Plan (DCIP) and Blue Ribbon Committee Update Mr. Lilleck provided information on DCIP and an update on the Blue Ribbon Commissions Potential Changes in Graduation Requirements and regionalization. He shared the promise to provide academic excellence to all students and ask questions like, what do we expect students to learn? How will we know they learned it? How will we respond when they do no learn? He shared that the Blue Ribbon Commission is exploring multiple pathways to graduation, assessment flexibility for students, culturally responsive curriculum and instruction. He also spoke about the regionalization discussion at the state to help create more opportunities for students.
