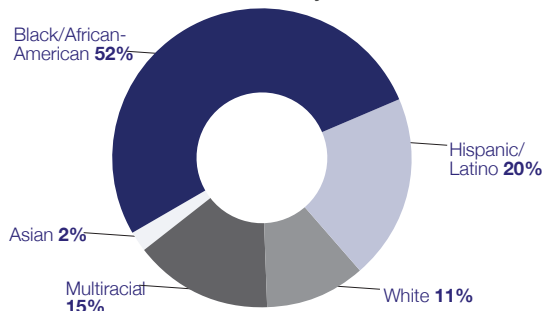

Graduation requirements

Students graduating in June of 2024 need to complete a personalized portfolio indicating their mastery of content, self-knowledge, and future plan. In addition, students need to pass the State of Wisconsin Civics Exam.

Capital High students meet graduation requirements via competency based teaching and learning and portfolio defense. Graduation requirements include the mastery of CCSS core benchmarks for literacy, mathematics, and science through a competency-based teaching and learning model with equivalency to align to the Carnegie credit graduation requirements.
