

2024-2025 Scholarship Listings

Alan & Jane Handler Scholarship- This scholarship is offered to students planning to attend the University of Rochester and looks to recognize academically high-achieving students with substantial levels of financial need, who have overcome significant obstacles in their lives. Recipients are selected on the basis of academic achievement, outstanding potential to be future leaders, and the ability to master complex challenges. In order to be considered for this scholarship, you must be nominated by your school counselor and must have completed the Common Application for the University of Rochester by December 1, 2024. If you are interested in being nominated, please see Mr. Behm or Mrs. Stahl in the House 1 office by November 12, 2024.

Boston University Trustees Scholarship Competition- Boston University's most prestigious merit-based award recognizes students who show outstanding academic and leadership abilities. Every year, Boston University welcomes about 20 outstanding students to the Trustees Scholars Program. Many of the current Scholars had perfect 4.0 GPAs in high school and typically ranked in the top 5-10% of their class. This scholarship covers full tuition and student fees for 4 years. <u>Canisius College Hassett Family Scholarship</u>- This scholarship covers full tuition for 4 years at Canisius College and is open to students majoring in Creative Writing. Talented and creative writers are encouraged to apply online. In order to be considered, students must apply to Canisius and select Creative Writing as their major, submit a creative writing sample (up to 10 pages), and include 1 letter of recommendation addressing their potential as a creative writer. <u>Daughters of the American Revolution Good Citizens Award</u>- All senior students, male and female, are invited to apply. <u>Davidson College John M. Belk Scholarship</u>- This scholarship recognizes powerful students who have demonstrated academic excellence, integrity, intellectual curiosity, willingness to take risks, and potential to be "change agents" in both our local and global communities. The scholarship covers full tuition, fees, and room & board for four years at Davidson College. In order to be considered for the scholarship, you must be nominated by your school counselor. **Please see Mr. Behm or Mrs. Stahl in the House 1 Office to place your name on the list for nomination by Tuesday, October 23, 2024**.

<u>Elks National Foundation, Inc.- Legacy Award</u>- This program awards \$4,000 scholarships to children and grandchildren of dues-paying Elk members. For more information and to apply, please visit https://www.elks.org/scholars/scholarships/legacy.cfm. The deadline is February 3, 2025.

Elks National Foundation, Inc.-Most Valuable Student Scholarship- Over 500 scholarships will be awarded to students based on academics, leadership, and financial need. National awards range from \$1,000 to \$12,500 per year. Students must be pursuing a four-year degree on a full-time basis at a college in the US. <u>Jefferson Scholars Foundation</u>- Jefferson Scholarships provide full tuition, fees, and a living stipend for four years of undergraduate study at the University of Virginia, plus a number of generous enrichment benefits, including a study abroad experience. Students must be nominated by their school counselor. If you are interested in being nominated, **please see Mr. Behm or Mrs. Stahl in the House 1 office by November 12, 2024.**

North Carolina State Textiles Scholarship - The NC State Textiles Scholarship Program offers several scholarship opportunities ranging from \$2,500 to \$22,000 per year for students pursuing any career that could impact the textile industry. If you are applying to the Wilson College of Textiles, you will automatically be considered for this scholarship when you apply. If you are pursuing a major outside of the Wilson College of Textiles, you must be endorsed by your school counselor. Please visit this link for more information:

Northeastern Torch Scholarship Program- The Torch Scholarship Program covers full tuition, room, and board to applicants who are first-generation college students, are from a low-income household (as determined by the FAFSA), and have persevered despite difficult situations that might keep them from reaching their full academic potential. Applicants must show leadership and community involvement as well as a desire to make a difference. Students with great potential and limited high school academic success will be considered. In order to be considered, you must be nominated by your school counselor. To be considered for nomination, please see Mr. Behm or Mrs. Stahl in House 1 office by December 10, 2024.

<u>Park Scholarships-North Carolina State University</u>- The Park Scholarship Program provides a four-year scholarship to North Carolina State University awarded on the basis of outstanding accomplishments and potential in scholarship, leadership, service, and character. To be considered, students must complete a Park Scholarship application AND an application for admission to North Carolina State University. Skidmore College Filene Music Scholarship- This \$80,000 scholarship is open to students interested in attending Skidmore College who plan to major in music or be active in music during college. The cost of private lessons is also covered by the program. Interested students must also apply for admission to Skidmore College by January 8, 2025. The Triangle Shirtwaist Factory Fire Memorial Scholarship- The Triangle Shirtwaist Factory Fire Memorial offers college scholarships of up to \$6,000 per academic year (\$3,000 per semester) to the children of workers who were permanently disabled or killed on the job and are receiving New York State workers' compensation benefits.
