Boston University Trustees Scholarship Competition- Boston University's most prestigious merit-based award recognizes students who show outstanding academic and leadership abilities. Every year, Boston University welcomes about 20 outstanding students to the Trustees Scholars Program. Many of the current Scholars had perfect 4.0 GPAs in high school and typically ranked in the top 5-10% of their class. This scholarship covers full tuition and student fees for 4 years. Application instructions are available online at http://bu.edu/admissions/trustee. The deadline is December 1, 2024.

<u>Daughters of the American Revolution Good Citizens Award</u>- All senior students, male and female, are invited to apply. "Good Citizens" are students who exemplify outstanding qualities of dependability, service, leadership, and patriotism in their school, home, or community. <u>Davidson College John M. Belk Scholarship</u>- This scholarship recognizes powerful students who have demonstrated academic excellence, integrity, intellectual curiosity, willingness to take risks, and potential to be "change agents" in both our local and global communities. The scholarship covers full tuition, fees, and room & board for four years at Davidson College. In order to be considered for the scholarship, you must be nominated by your school counselor. **Please see Mr. Behm or Mrs. Stahl in the House 1 Office to place your name on the list for nomination by Tuesday, October 23, 2024**.

Elks National Foundation, Inc.-Most Valuable Student Scholarship- Over 500 scholarships will be awarded to students based on academics, leadership, and financial need. <u>Jefferson Scholars Foundation</u>- Jefferson Scholarships provide full tuition, fees, and a living stipend for four years of undergraduate study at the University of Virginia, plus a number of generous enrichment benefits, including a study abroad experience. Leonard Bus Sales "A Day in the Life of a School Bus" Scholarship Competition- This scholarship competition aims to recognize and encourage the artistic talent of high school juniors and seniors across NYS. Leonard Bus Sales, Inc. encourages students to depict a day in the life of the average school bus; to capture the places it goes and the things it sees. Lester B. Pearson International Scholarship- This scholarship is open to students planning to attend the University of Toronto. The nominee should be a creative thinker with an exceptional academic record who is recognized as a leader within the school and exhibits the potential to contribute positively to the global community and to the future. Pearson scholars will receive full funding for four years of tuition, books and living costs, and gain a global perspective on issues that matter most to them. In order to be considered, you must be nominated by your school. To be considered for nomination, please see Mr. Behm or Mrs. Stahl in the House 1 office by October 1, 2024.

<u>Park Scholarships-North Carolina State University</u>- The Park Scholarship Program provides a four-year scholarship to North Carolina State University awarded on the basis of outstanding accomplishments and potential in scholarship, leadership, service, and character. To be considered, students must complete a Park Scholarship application AND an application for admission to North Carolina State University. The Triangle Shirtwaist Factory Fire Memorial Scholarship- The Triangle Shirtwaist Factory Fire Memorial offers college scholarships of up to \$6,000 per academic year (\$3,000 per semester) to the children of workers who were permanently disabled or killed on the job and are receiving New York State workers' compensation benefits.
