- Approved all Consensus Items, including the adoption of the textbook World History, Voices & Perspective by Jackson J. Spielvogel, published by McGraw Hill, copyright 2023, Middle School, World History 6th grade
- Approved the bond for the purchase of buses approved by voters in May 2024.
- Approved the school breakfast and lunch prices for the 24–25 school year. The prices will be the same as 23–24. The Ala Carte prices were approved with some increases.
- Approved the contract extension with Personal Touch for School Food Services and the Transportation contract extension with Fisher Bus Services.
- Accepted donations from the Jewish Federation of Greater Buffalo of 250 for the Middle School Social Studies department and their work with the Holocaust Resource Center.





Action Continued:

- First Read of Changes to Policy 5661: Wellness Mrs. Hornung reviewed the suggested changes to the policy. She shared the recommended changes and improvements to language in the policy. - Zero Emission Buses Implementation Timeline Dr. Rogers shared that the resolution is in regards to extending the timeline for districts to meet this mandate. Mr. Petrus reviewed what the district has done so far to meet the requirements from the state for planning for the costly implementation. The Board will review the resolution at their next meeting.
