- ❖ To be eligible for any of these scholarships, you must be enrolled as a graduating senior at Dawson High School before the end of the second 9 weeks of the 2024 – 2025 school year.
- ❖ If you are awarded a scholarship, it is **MANDATORY** that you attend the senior awards ceremony. You will be notified in advance if you are a recipient of any scholarships, so you are able to make arrangements to attend the ceremony.

Instructions for submitting each application:

Please read each scholarship carefully as they may have different requirements.

1. Make copies of the personal information and student profile pages (pages 2 and 3) and attach it to each application.
2. The signed application must be stapled in front of the requested requirements for each application.
3. If the application requests a transcript, go to skyward to print one out. If the application requests an **official transcript**, go to the counseling center or to the webstore to request one. Official transcripts cost \$2.00 each and please allow 2-3 days for processing.
4. Each application must be put in its own manila envelope. **Put your full name and the name of the scholarship on the front of each envelope.**
5. **Page 4** needs to be turned in when you turn in all the scholarship applications.
6. Once completed, turn into Mrs. Merritt in the **Counseling office no later than February 7th at 2:45pm.**

Note: If awarded a scholarship it can take several months to get the money sent to your college. Make sure you turn in any information requested by the scholarship sponsor immediately to ensure your funds arrive in time.

Remember, page 4 needs to be signed by Mrs. Merritt when you drop off the applications. **Applications will not be accepted after this date and time.** The counseling team will not be responsible for checking if you have all your documents. Please make sure to double check all requirements before submitting.

GUIDELINES FOR BRAZORIA-GALVESTON
COUNTY FARM BUREAU
SCHOLARSHIP
2025

- I. The Scholarship Committee of Brazoria-Galveston County Farm Bureau will select an individual to receive a \$4,000 scholarship.

- II. To be eligible to receive the scholarship, an applicant must:
 - a. Be a graduating high school senior of a Brazoria or Galveston County high school or a home school student residing in Brazoria or Galveston County.
 - b. Turn in completed application form accompanied by a high school transcript, SAT and/or ACT test results (if applicable) and three (3) letters of reference.
 - c. Plan to attend a college, technical or trade school and take a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester. (Will be required to provide proof of registration.)
 - d. Be the son or daughter of a current **Brazoria-Galveston County Farm Bureau** member. If awarded, parents must maintain membership for the duration of the scholarship.

- III. The money will be paid directly to the college/school as follows:
 - 1st Year-** \$500 the fall semester upon proof of registration for a minimum of 12 credit hours. \$500 the spring semester, upon proof of registration for a minimum of 12 credit hours and a minimum **2.0** GPA maintained the preceding semester.
 - 2nd Year-** \$500 the fall semester and \$500 the spring semester with registration for 12 credit hours minimum and minimum **2.0** GPA the preceding semester.
 - 3rd Year-** \$500 the fall semester and \$500 the spring semester with registration for 12 credit hours minimum and minimum **2.0** GPA the preceding semester.
 - 4th Year-** \$500 the fall semester and \$500 the spring semester with registration for 12 credit hours minimum and a minimum **2.0** GPA the preceding semester. *Scholarship stops if at any time the requirements for a semester are not met.*

4. Provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher or school administrator. (Provider may not be related to student.)
5. Provide completed Dawson PTA's 2025 Senior Scholarship Qualification Form
6. Provide a one-page typed essay on the following topic:

“Describe how you have demonstrated community involvement both in and out of school.”

7. Provide a half page minimum to one-page maximum typed essay on the following topic:

“How did the PTA positively affect your school career?”

- Both essays must be typed, double spaced, size 12 Times New Roman font.
- Provide a word count at the end of both essays.
- Do not include your name on the essay. Instead, use your PISD Student ID number.
- Completed essays must be in a sealed envelope with the student's name and student ID number, and included with the completed Dawson PTA scholarship application packet.

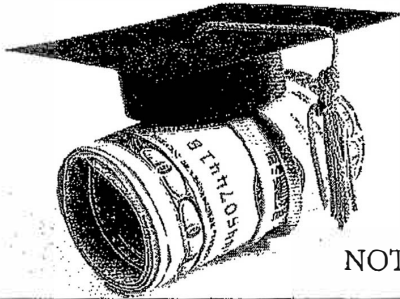

Scholarship Criteria

Gulf Coast Educators Federal Credit Union will present scholarships annually in the amount of \$500.00 per semester for 4 years – a total of \$4,000.00 – to four qualified students selected from applicants within our field of membership who meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. Applicant must be a high school senior.

2. Student must be a member in good standing with GCEFCU and parent/legal guardian must be a member in good standing with GCEFCU.

3. Two scholarships may be awarded to students who express the intent to pursue a course of study that will allow him or her to enter the teaching field. Two scholarships may be awarded to applicants outside the field of education. However, the Committee reserves the right to award scholarships solely based on the areas of consideration listed (#7).

4. Recipient of the scholarship funds must maintain a minimum G.P.A. of 2.5 and earn at least twelve hours minimum each semester. A transcript must be received after each semester to show the recipient is within the requirements as set forth by the Board. Failure to comply will result in permanent forfeiture.

5. The scholarship will be used for the purpose of study at an accredited college or university.

6. Scholarship funds will be paid each semester to the school of the recipient's choice when evidence of enrollment and G.P.A. (copy of transcript or grades) maintained is presented to GCEFCU.

7. Areas of consideration for selection will include need, academic achievement, character, leadership, and personal recommendations.

8. If selected as a finalist, the applicant may be required to participate in a personal interview.

9. Selections will be determined by a committee appointed from the Board of Directors of GCEFCU.

10. If the committee's first choice does not accept the scholarship, a second candidate will be selected.

11. A candidate must have a minimum combined SAT score of 1000 and/or a minimum ACT score of 21.
