Using federal Title 1 funds and goals, Old Turnpike School has designed an English Language Arts and Mathematics intervention program called ASAP (Academic Support and Achievement Program). To best meet students' individual learning needs, the English Language Arts (ELA) ASAP program will be taught by the grade level ELA teacher, and the Mathematics ASAP program will be taught by the grade level math teacher.

Your child is eligible and will receive academic support this year in the area(s) of **ELA/Math**. This learning intervention is being offered to students who were identified in need of additional support. This was determined by assessment scores on the State/district assessments, a recommendation from the previous teacher, marking period grades, and/or a recommendation from the I&RS team.

This program allows for your child to receive additional support classes one day a week during E&R time (Enrichment and Remediation) in the identified content area(s). The extra class periods will create opportunities for small group instruction and support individual student's individual learning needs. The goal of ASAP is to provide the necessary intervention to motivate learning, help students understand concepts, and practice skills needed for future learning.
