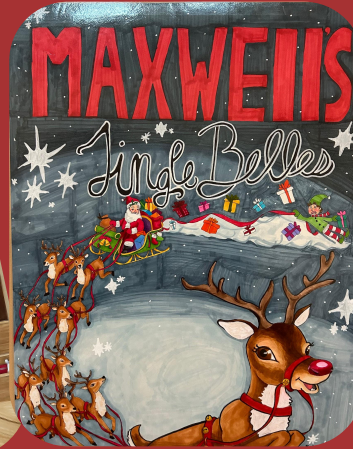
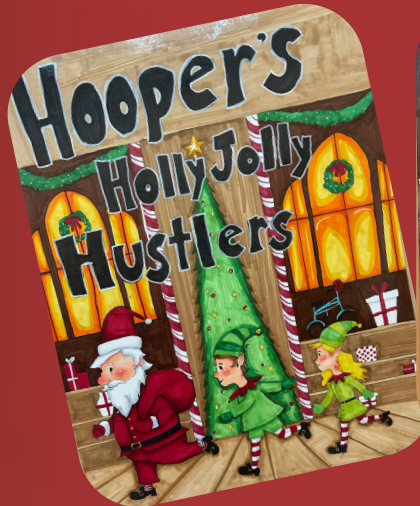

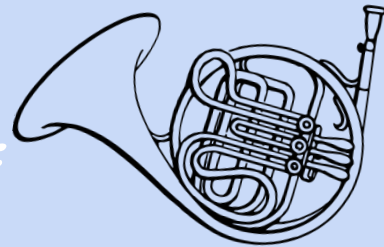


Choir Christmas Concert
