



### **School Environment**


#### **CLASS SIZE**

#### **REGULAR ATTENDERS**


Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

#### **ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE**


Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.



### **Academic Success**


#### **ON-TIME GRADUATION**

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2019-20 graduating in 2022-23.




### FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

### School Goals

BIS seeks to provide a strong educational base through integrated subjects to prepare students for college and career. Organizational and curricular philosophies aim to encourage persistence in setting and attaining goals, working to maximize a student's potential, and inspiring curiosity to go further. BIS maintains a professional atmosphere to mirror the professional world by emphasizing employability skills in teamwork, communication, and problem solving. Students gain valuable technology skills through innovative core projects in business and marketing, math, science, art and design, world languages, and the humanities.

#### **State Goals**

# Safe & Welcoming Environment

Our school ensures all students and parents feel welcome in our school office and with our school communication. We have access to bilingual staff and can have all communication translated. We provide interpreters for registration, parent conferences and presentation nights. BIS ensures a safe and secure environment for all students. BIS uses ALICE training, a developed School Safety Plan, and developed lessons that include strategies to deal with bullying. We offer counseling services through La Clinica and use our Student Service Team (SST) to identify students who are harassing others and find ways to support the victim.








# ADVANCED COURSEWORK

Crater School of BIS offers advanced coursework in the following areas:

- AP Calculus, AP US Government and Politics, AP Psychology, AP US History, AP English
- Elective Courses are also offered in Marketing, Entrepreneurship, CAD, Engineering, Computer programing and Forensics
- · Students in our TAG program are given advanced coursework in their core subject areas
- Dual credit courses through Klamath Community College and Southern Oregon University
- We have a Two-Way Immersion English/Spanish program (currently for 9th grade, expanding each year).

# CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Our students have the option of experiencing career and technical education through coursework, clubs and new grant programs. Crater School of BIS offers a variety of classes in agricultural education. Veterinary science, horticulture, floral design, and animal science are some of the offerings. Trade and technical offerings including Welding, CAD, Furniture Design, and design competition. In partnership with Klamath Community College, BIS offers many dual credit courses that give students college credit courses in Math, Science, English and Business.

# EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Our school offers several extracurricular activities. Sports that are offered include: Football, Soccer, Cross Country, Volleyball, Boys and Girls Basketball, Wrestling, Swimming, Equestrian, Track and Field

We also offer academic extracurricular activities: Speech and Debate, Honor Society, State of Jeff Academic Scavenger Hunt. FFA. and DECA

# PARENT & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Our school holds family nights including Exhibition Night, performances, concerts, information nights, and Open House "Meet and Greets." At each event we offer sign-ups of local services. This includes La Clinica Physical and Mental Health support and Food/Shelter services. We also offer ParentSquare, a way to communicate with parents via text, in English and Spanish. BIS partners with businesses in the area. These partnerships involve medical services, "wrap around" services for low income families or families. We have partnerships with local churches, Threads of Hope and faith-based organizations that supply families with food, gifts and clothing. We partner with the Crater Foundation to provide every Crater High School graduate with a scholarship to a post graduate program.
