Visalia Unified Coordinated School Health Advisory Committee

The VUSD Coordinated School Health Advisory Committee serves as an advisory body to the administration and staff of the Visalia Unified School District. The Committee is composed of three primary groups:

- Members of the community with an interest in health education
- VUSD administrators
- Certificated and classified staff of VUSD

As an advisory body, the Coordinated School Health Advisory Committee has no decision-making responsibilities.

Committee meetings provide a setting for communication and discussion in which all members of the community can become involved in the process of school district decision-making. The Coordinated School Health Advisory Committee provides an opportunity for the administration to receive community input and perceptions early in planning and decision-making processes in the area of health.

The committee's membership is dynamic and is not closed. Participants strive to reflect the cultural and economic diversity of the greater community. Members do not vote, nor is there any requirement for participants to reach consensus. District administration is charged with making administrative decisions. The administration seeks to hear a full range of viewpoints expressed during meetings in making administrative decisions and providing recommendations to the VUSD Board of Education.
