The Oldham County Middle School Council met at Oldham County Middle School in Buckner, Kentucky on Thursday, November 14, 2024 for a Meeting.

Council Items- The meeting was called to order by Mr. Caldwell at 4:20 p.m.

1. Review of the Agenda – A motion was made by Laura Setters to approve the Agenda. It was seconded by Mary Reed and approved by consensus.
2. Approval of October Draft Minutes – A motion was made Laura Setters to approve the Draft Minutes. It was seconded by Mary Reed and approved by consensus.
3. Council Action and Review Items.
  - a. Review of CSIP Phase 2. Mr. Caldwell reviewed with Counsel CSIP Phase 2 and explained all pertinent objectives and goals of needs assessment.
4. Principal Update.
  - a. KDE 2- day Review. Mr. Caldwell explained to Counsel we are currently in TSI. KDE is doing a 2-day instructional audit. They will be writing up a report which we will receive back in 4-6 weeks. They will make recommendations to us. We will most likely receive the report after our drafting and reviewing the OCMS CSIP which is due January 1, 2025.
  - b. Curriculum Committee – ELA. The first meeting of this committee will take place on the 21<sup>st</sup>. It will be made up of ELA Teachers, Special Education Co-Teachers, Liz Dant and some District people. This committee will work to determine our vision of ELA instruction. We will look at piloting some literacy skills companion programs. Some of our county elementary and high schools are currently using/piloting some of these programs. The committee will reach out to those schools to get feedback and recommendations. (StudySync-HS, Reading IQ-LA, and Savvas-BU were programs that were mentioned).
  - c. TSI Committee Work – TSI stands for Targeted Support and Improvement, which is a federal designation for schools that need to improve outcomes for specific student groups. The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires state educational agencies to identify schools that are eligible for TSI. TSI schools are identified based on student groups that are performing poorly

compared to their peers. These groups include Black/African American, Hispanic/Latino, Native American/Alaska Native, Asian, students with disabilities, English learners and economically disadvantaged students. Mr. Caldwell shared the number of students we currently have at OCMS with IEPs and that the majority of those students are close to moving up. We are auditing the individual services they students need. We are working closely with our Special Education Teachers thru co-teaching cohorts, students are given additional services through their REP periods.

- d. Update on Personnel. Roxana Gonzalez made a motion to take us into closed session at 5:09 p.m. Heather Dremov seconded the motion. Session was closed by consensus. Session was reopened at 5:27 p.m.

5. General Public Feedback – None at this time.

6. At 5:28 p.m. motion was made by Laura Setters to adjourn the meeting which was seconded by Mary Reed and approved by consensus. Mr. Caldwell adjourned the regular held meeting.
