#### OTHER FEES:

- Registration Fee (compulsory) €400 p.a.
- Parents/Guardians Association subscription (compulsory) \*<sup>1</sup> €50 p.a.
- Optional Extended Day Programme (13:45-15:15, excluding Wednesday) \*<sup>2</sup> €860 p.a. (2 instalments: Oct. & Jan.)
- Lunch (option available for all Years) €825 p.a. (5 instalments: Oct.-Feb.)
- Breakfast (option available for all Years) €600 p.a. (5 instalments: Oct.-Feb.)
- Lab Fees/Consumables (compulsory for Years 4-6):
  - Chemistry IGCSE/A Level €100 p.a. (1 instalment: Oct.)
  - Biology IGCSE/A Level €100 p.a. (1 instalment: Oct.)
  - Physics IGCSE/A Level €100 p.a. (1 instalment: Oct.)
  - Art IGCSE/A Level €100 p.a. (1 instalment: Oct.)
- IB DP School Administration Fee (compulsory for Years 5 IB & 6 IB) €400 p.a. (5 instalments: Oct.-Feb.)
- Athletic Section Fee (compulsory for athletes of all Years) €800 p.a. (5 instalments: Oct.-Feb.)
- Excursions (compulsory for all pupils) \*<sup>3</sup> €50 p.a. (1 instalment: Sep.)

#### NOTES:

1. Our Year 1 corresponds to Year 7 of the UK educational system.
2. On Registration the following are payable (total €2,700):
  - Registration Fee €400
  - Parents/Guardians Association subscription €50
  - Towards the annual Tuition Fees €2,250
3. The balance of the annual Tuition Fees is payable in 6 equal instalments (September-February)
4. \*<sup>1</sup> Parents/Guardians Association subscription:
  - €50 per family for 1 child
  - €20 additionally per family per sibling
  - The pupils of the Athletic Section pay an additional €10 for the Personal Accident Insurance Policy.
  - Parents/Guardians Association subscription for PASCAL Kindergarten/PASCAL Primary School is paid separately.
5. Sibling discount of €500 is given on the Tuition Fees of each of the older children.

6. Parents/guardians of continuing pupils are required to reserve places for the upcoming academic year by 31<sup>st</sup> January 2025. Places must be reserved during the period stipulated with the amount of €750. This amount will be deducted from the total amount of €2,700 which is payable on registration for the upcoming academic year (see note 2 above).
7. The cost for the school uniform, the books (excluding the ones provided for free by the Cyprus Ministry of Education, Sport and Youth), the school transportation, the extra-curricular activities and the participation in competitions, conferences, etc. is not included in this pricelist. More information regarding these costs can be obtained from the school reception.
8. \*<sup>2</sup> Optional Extended Day Programme (Academic/Homework Support): The subjects taught are Mathematics, Science and English. English is taught two times a week whereas Science and Mathematics are each taught once a week. Pupils may choose to follow only one subject once a week, and the fee is €215 p.a.
9. \*<sup>3</sup> Excursions: The excursions charge relates to the transportation cost only. Any other related costs (e.g. entrance fee, food) are payable separately.
10. The fee for the external examinations depends on the subject/level/examination body and is charged separately.
11. Fees can be settled via credit card, JCC Smart, wire transfers, monthly instalments by credit card or standing order.
12. Tuition and other fees are reviewed annually. Any possible increment on the Tuition Fees and the Registration Fee has a cap of 8% on the fees of each Year for an academic year. For continuing and new pupils in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 the cap is 5%.
13. Reservation Fee, Registration Fee, Tuition Fees, Parents/Guardians Association subscription and Athletic Section Fee are not refundable under any circumstances as they guarantee (represent a deposit) a pupil's attendance at school for at least one academic year. Hence, this is not simply an advance fee payment.
14. The inability to continue with school lessons, for whatever reason, does not exempt the parent/guardian/pupil from the obligation to pay the school fees for the whole academic year. Any balance of fees due upon the departure of a pupil from the school, irrespective of the date of departure, must be paid in full. In the event that fees of a pupil were paid in full and the pupil ceases to attend the school, no refund is applicable. The departure of any pupil in no way minimizes the school's running costs.
15. A Late Payment Penalty Fee of €50 per month applies if the payment is not made by the applicable instalment deadline.
16. The school has the right to withdraw scholarships, monetary prizes or discounts in case the fees are not paid by the applicable instalment deadline.
17. The Teachers Council has the right to withdraw scholarships, monetary prizes or discounts in case of serious disciplinary incident or disciplinary infringement.
18. For those pupils whose fees are met partially or in total by the Cyprus Government (such as Maronites, Armenians, Latins, repatriated Cypriots, Turkish-Cypriots and so on), it is the obligation of the parents/guardians/pupils to settle the school fees according to the applicable deadlines irrespective of when the subsidy is received from the Government.
19. Enrolment in the subsequent academic year will be accepted only once the due fees and other financial obligations have been settled.
