

**District #90: SHARE Interlibrary Loan
Permission Slip**

District #90 is part of the SHARE Library Consortium. This allows your junior high student to request items from libraries outside of District 90 via interlibrary loan. These requested items come from one of over 500 libraries across the state, including public as well as high school libraries.

If you wish to grant your consent for you student to request items through the interlibrary loan, please understand the following and sign below:

- Authorization grants students access to books from Juvenile to Young Adult levels. In our District #90 junior high libraries, we currently order Juvenile titles only.
- Requests can be made for physical books only. Video games, DVDs, electronic items, etc. are not permitted.
- If the borrowed items are not returned or are damaged, the student will be responsible for the fees to replace the item. These fees are determined by the library that owns the item, not by the District #90 library.
- You can access your student’s library account online via the school’s online card catalog. This allows you to see what they are requesting or currently have checked out, as well as due dates, renewal options, and any fines. Instructions for accessing this account can be found on the District 90’s website on the Library & Media page. To find the instructions, select “Quicklinks for Staff and Students,” and then select “Account Access & Renewals Via Share.”
