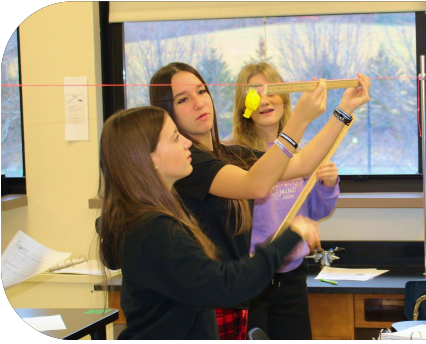

We measure success through the development of kind, knowledgeable, and collaborative leaders.



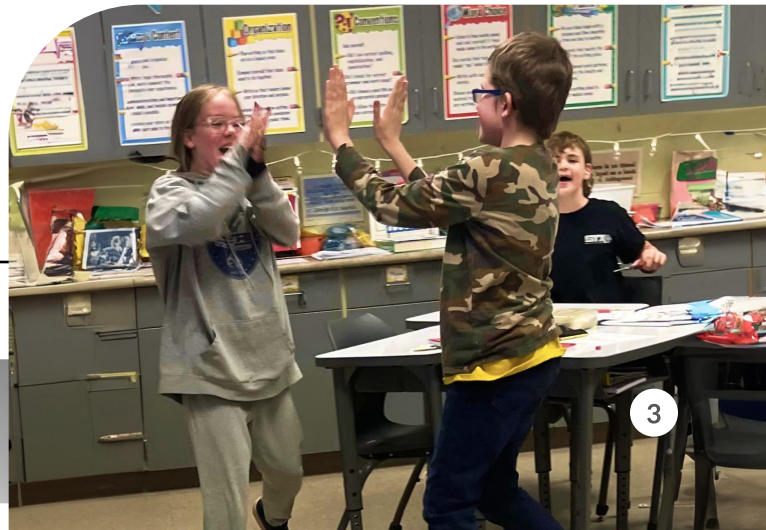

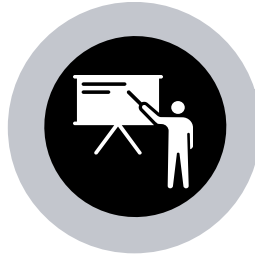

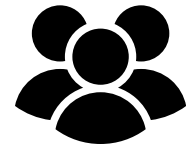
