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MAGNET SCHOOL OPTIONS

Our magnet schools offer a tailored curriculum that focuses on specific areas of interest, such as science, technology, and the arts. We provide a rich learning experience that will ignite your child's passion for learning from a young age. Free transportation is available to and from all magnet schools if you live within the school districts of Anoka-Hennepin, Brooklyn Center, Buffalo-Hanover-Montrose, Elk River-Otsego-Rogers-Zimmerman, Fridley, Osseo and Rockford.

BIRCH GROVE SCHOOL FOR THE ARTS

At Birch Grove School for the Arts, core curriculum is integrated with music, dance, drama and visual arts for daily classroom instruction. Arts-rich electives and arts troupes provide additional opportunities for scholars to "learn through our passion for the arts."

WEAVER LAKE: A SCIENCE, MATH & TECHNOLOGY SCHOOL

At Weaver Lake, learning takes place as scholars investigate the world around them. Scholars discover answers and solve challenges through reading, research and investigation.

ZANEWOOD COMMUNITY: A STEAM SCHOOL

At Zanewood Community: A Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math School, scholars are taught to be problem solvers, creators and collaborators. SPECIAL EDUCATION OPTIONS

First magnet school lottery deadline

- Birch Grove School for the Arts
- Weaver Lake: A Science, Math & Technology School
- Zanewood Community: A STEAM School (Note: A lottery application is required only for students who live outside the Zanewood attendance area.)

JAN. 15, 2025

Open enrollment lottery deadline

(In-district transfers and non-resident students)

Applications received after Jan. 15, 2025 will be considered in the order received based on space availability.

MARCH 7, 2025

Second magnet school lottery deadline

If you applied before the first magnet school lottery deadline and were not accepted, you will automatically be entered into the second magnet school lottery. You do not need to reapply.

MARCH - MAY 2025

Attend kindergarten orientation

AUG. 2025

Transportation eligible students: Check ParentVUE and/or watch for an email with bus information

Transportation details will be emailed and added to ParentVUE under Student Info. to enrolled families in late Aug. Transportation is provided to elementary students who live 0.8 mile or more from school. Parents/caregivers of students who are open enrolled (including in-district transfers) are responsible for their student's transportation.

To determine the school assigned to your home address, visit district279.org/findmyschool.

Schedule your child's Early Childhood Screening appointment

Screening is free and includes a check of vision, hearing, and developmental progress and a review of immunizations. The ideal time for screening is between ages three and four. Schedule your appointment at district279.org/screeningapt.

Update your child's immunizations*

Minnesota requires that all kindergartners show they have received immunizations or an exemption* for the following: diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (DTP); measles, mumps and rubella (MMR); polio; varicella (chicken pox); and hepatitis B. For information about immunizations or the free immunization clinic, please call 763-585-7350.

*Legal exemptions are allowed—both for medical reasons and conscientiously held beliefs.
