## 2. MDE New Parent Dashboard

MDE has launched a new parent dashboard that will provide a versatile transparency system of school data, showing the performance of all K-12 public schools in Michigan. A direct link to the site is on the homepage of the district website. Families and community members can use the dashboard to compare a school's performance with the average performance of other, similar Michigan schools, including charter schools. The dashboard allows deeper dives into the performance of various groups of students such as gender, race, subject, and services to students, and shows nearly 20 separate measures that parents say are important to them.

The dashboard is being rolled out in three phases. The first phase includes measures such as state assessment performance, state assessment progress, graduation rate, advanced coursework (Advanced Placement, Dual Enrollment, CTE postsecondary), on-track attendance, student/staff ratio, student transfers, expulsion rate and drop-out rate.

Future phases of the Parent Dashboard will include new data not previously reported for schools. Proposed categories include early learning access, access to technology, services to students with disabilities, English learners and extracurricular activities. We encourage parents to take some time to check out the new dashboard!
