Ben Lippen School seeks a talented leader with energy and vision, honed by significant experience in Christian school education. This is a compelling leadership opportunity for a man or woman with a proven track record to build on our rich tradition and move the school to a new level of excellence in collaboration with Columbia International University. The position begins in the summer of 2025.

# FOUNDING AND HISTORY

More than 80 years ago, Columbia International University (CIU), formerly Columbia Bible College, envisioned a model school, a center of influence in the Christian school movement that would instill Christian discipleship, high academic standards, and a call to world evangelization.

Ben Lippen, a Scottish phrase meaning "Mountain of Trust," was established as a conference center in the refreshing mountain air of Asheville, North Carolina. It provided a peaceful retreat from South Carolina's summer heat, offering a serene setting for biblical study, encouragement, and spiritual growth. Robert C. McQuilkin, CIU's first president, realized that the Ben Lippen summer could meet a need for quality Christian education year-round. With this in mind, Ben Lippen School was founded in 1940 as an evangelical boarding school for boys.

The school became co-educational in 1952 and flourished as a school for missionary children. Following a fire that destroyed the main building in 1980, Ben Lippen relocated to the campus of Columbia Bible College in 1988, in Columbia, South Carolina.

Today, Ben Lippen School operates across three Columbia locations: the Monticello Road campus, home to our PK3-12th grades and International Boarding Program; the St. Andrews Road campus, serving PK3-4th grade; and the Northeast campus, offering PK4-4th grade. Total enrollment has grown from 758 to 1220 students in the past eight years. Families served by Ben Lippen represent a diverse selection of Columbia area churches and several foreign countries. The school continues its tradition of serving as a model of academic distinction with Ben Lippen students receiving \$9,291,760 in college scholarships for the class of 2024. Throughout its history, Ben Lippen graduates have been accepted to some of the finest colleges and universities in the country, building their lives on biblical values as they contribute to society in a variety of professions.

Ben Lippen School is a CESA member of council accredited through Cognia, and the Small Boarding School Association (SBSA). Ben Lippen is also a National Blue Ribbon School (NBRS).
