Public Budget Hearing: 2016-17 Proposed Budget

Just a reminder to the school community that a public meeting was held on November 9, 2015 providing citizens with the opportunity to learn more as well as address questions or concerns regarding the proposal to impose a summer tax levy of all annual school taxes, following discussion at the open meetings on July 20, September 14 and October 12. On November 9, 2015 the Board passed the proposed resolution.

Effective July 1, 2016 APPS will collect all of the annual school property taxes, including debt service during the summer. Note: This is consistent with existing practice in Melvindale and Southgate Public School Districts and will save APPS approximately \$41,000 annually.
