	Board Work Session: Presentations – Project Manager for Athletic Facilities Renovation Project ▪ McCarthy & Smith – William McCarthy, Doug Underwood McCarthy & Smith, Inc. have been building strong communities since 1965 – 85% of work is constructing and remodeling PK-12 facilities. Over 450 educational facilities in the last 25 years; 15 new turf fields, 6 replacement turf fields since 2005. Pre-Construction Services were emphasized – estimating, budgeting, value engineering, work plan development. Mr. McCarthy and Mr. Underwood shared the scope of improvements and estimated costs, with items to consider. Emphasis was also placed on a proposed timeline for the project, including most ideal bid climate, design/engineering process, geo testing, architect, landscape architect, civil engineer and submission for Wayne County Review/Approval. ▪ Barton Malow – Steven Rewers Barton Malow is the largest K-12 construction management company in the state of Michigan, with leading bidder participation in the industry. Barton Malow provides designer (Foresight), soil borings and survey engineering team. Discussion ensued regarding water retention and best placement. When discussing a timeline for the project, Mr. Rewers indicated that he was prepared to get started on the project right away and could expedite project, weather permitting.
