Presentation: Special Education Compliance Update - Matthew Sokol, Ph.D., Ed.S. Dr. Sokol provided the Board with a brief update on the Continuous Improvement and Monitoring System (CIMS), which is the system used by MDE to promote positive outcomes and ensure compliance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) of 2004 and the Michigan Administrative Rules for Special Education. CIMS was designed to help school districts analyze and interpret data and keep track of all monitoring activities in a single location. Dr. Sokol assured the Board that APPS is in compliance in all components of Special Education. Additionally, Mr. Phil Pittman joined Dr. Sokol in providing the Board with an update on the MTSS (Multitiered System of Supports) initiative, which is in the second year of implementation at the elementary level. The goal of the MTSS framework is to ensure high levels of engagement and achievement for all students through the use of a coordinated, collaborative, data-driven school-wide system. Integrated, evidence-based instruction and intervention is delivered to students in varying intensities (tiers) based on individual needs and response to instruction so that each student is successful in meeting grade level academic and behavioral expectations. This "all hands on deck" approach allows for general education and special education staff to work together on interventions for students. The focus at the elementary is reading and the goal is to increase reading proficiency. Elementary staff have received training from literacy experts and a brief report was provided regarding use of MDE-Early Literacy (Section 35a) Grant funds. 17-09 Personnel Motion by Miller, supported by Marten, that the recommendation for employment of Erin Scroggins as Bus Driver/Transportation, effective December 13, 2016 be approved.
