Tanya Duffy, APHS Counselor, volunteered to serve as the School Coordinator. There is no cost to participate and selected students who stay in the program for 3 or 4 years have the opportunity to earn significant scholarship dollars. Jennifer Volappi, founder of the program, is a 1976 APHS graduate and in the Academic Hall of Fame.
