# **MEVSD Faces Budget Cuts After Levy Defeat**

On November 5th, Marysville Schools' levy proposal was not approved. prompting a series of budget adjustments which will align resources with current financial realities. While the district hoped for a positive outcome, the levy's failure required the district to proceed with contingency measures approved by the Board of Education on July 25, 2024. These adjustments, affecting extracurricular fees, program offerings, and staffing, are essential to maintain a balanced budget as the district navigates the path forward.

#### **Changes for 2025-2026**



Class Sizes: We will maintain the class size caps set after the May 2023 levy failure, with Kindergarten classes at 28 students, grades 1-6 at 30 students, and grades 7-12 at 35 students.



Hiring Freeze: A hiring freeze remains in effect, except for positions essential to state and federal compliance and maintaining class size limits.

#### **Program and Position Reductions:**



Adjustments across elementary, intermediate, middle, and high schools will involve reductions or eliminations in Art, Music, Physical Education, and various specialized subjects, such as STEM, Foreign Language, and advanced electives.

### **Immediate Changes for** 2024-2025

#### **Extracurricular Activities:**



Pay-to-participate fees will increase to \$235 for Show Choir & Band; \$575 for Athletics, with no cap. This adjustment will be effective for the winter sports and activities season.



**School Resource Officer Program:** The SRO program was eliminated in alignment with contract guidelines after Thanksgiving Break.

#### **Looking Ahead**

The District is taking steps to place a 5.5-mill, 10-year emergency property tax levy on the May 2025 ballot. The levy, which would fund daily operations, is estimated to cost \$192.50 annually per \$100,000 of home value. If the May 2025 levy passes, the district could potentially save the programs/positions at risk noted above, as well as bringing back SROs and reducing participation fees.


