BUSINESS DIVISION | 2024-25 FIRST INTERIM BUDGET REPORT

The Business Division provided an update to the Board of Trustees on the First Interim Financial Report. This interim budget report details the financial status of WSD. Key aspects include revenue and expenditure breakdowns (showing a projected deficit), multi-year financial projections based on enrollment trends and cost adjustments, and a discussion of the state's fiscal outlook. The report also addresses budget certification requirements, indicating the district's financial health, and references the impact of Proposition 98 funding. BUSINESS DIVISION | SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Business Division provided an update to the Board of Trustees on the School Resource Officer (SRO) program. It highlights the program's current success in improving safety, developing community engagement, and enabling proactive interventions in schools, citing positive survey results and studies showing reduced violence and improved attendance. However, it acknowledges potential challenges such as budget constraints, concerns about the SRO role, and equity considerations. The presentation concludes by proposing a phased expansion plan, including forming a task force, developing a comprehensive plan, securing funding, and engaging the community.
