### Banana Bread Recipe By Zoey St. John

#### Serves:10

### **Ingredients**

- 1/2 cup butter, softened
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- · 2 eggs, beaten
- · 3 bananas, crushed
- 1 ½ cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon vanilla (optional)
- Preferred amount of sliced almonds(optional)

### Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350° F
- 2. Mix together butter and sugar.
- 3. Add eggs and crushed bananas.
- 4. Combine well.
- 5. Sift together flour, baking soda and salt.
- 6. Add to banana mixture.
- 7. Add vanilla (optional).
- 8. Mix until fully combined. Do not overmix.
- 9. Pour into greased loaf pan.
- 10. Add sliced almonds on top (optional).
- 11. Bake at 350°F for 55 minutes.
- 12. Let cool down.

Making this was a truly enjoyable experience for my family and I. Such a simple dish can create memories to cherish forever. The banana bread was perfectly moist and absolutely delicious! I recommend adding something extra like walnuts or almonds. I am genuinely grateful for being able to share this recipe to whomever reads this.


So, break open your piggy banks! Bring some money and stop by the school store during your lunch period or at the end of the day!

#### DANDY'S WORLD TWISTED GUIDE

Dandy's World on Roblox has a large number of characters which are known as toons. Every single toon in the game has something called a twisted form. You must progress through the round by completing floors. To do this, you have to extract machines and survive the twisteds. There are 23 playable toons and 5 of them are main characters. These main characters are harder to find, as they are less likely to encounter and are harder to survive.

1) TWISTED ASTRO - Twisted Astro is the most common twisted to encounter during a round. When you get Astro, you will hear tiny footsteps. This means you have gotten Twisted Astro on your floor. When you mess up a machine with Twisted Astro on your floor, he will run towards the machine and drink 50% of the Ichor completed inside of the machine. Twisted Astro makes you Tired when he spots you. It makes your stamina regeneration really slow.



2) TWISTED SPROUT - Twisted Sprout is another one of the main characters. His twisted is the second most common twisted main. You can hear his footsteps, they sound kind of like when you are stepping on leaves. He makes gagging noises like he's choking on the ichor in his mouth. Ichor is the black stuff that "infects" the toons and turns them into twisteds. When he spots you, he shoots a puddle of ichor on the ground near you and a giant tentacle appears in that puddle. If you try to walk in the puddle, the tentacle will hit you and then you will lose a heart.




3) TWISTED SHELLY - Twisted Shelly is a main twisted that is pretty fast. You can hear her footsteps only when she is nearby. She appears a lot less than Twisted Sprout and Twisted Astro. You can hear her growling when she's on your floor. Shelly has a giant dinosaur tail because of her obsession with dinosaurs. You will know when she's on your floor because the word "Confused" will appear above your head. She's a very cool twisted but it's not that easy to survive her unless you're fast.



4) TWISTED PEBBLE - Twisted Pebble is the fastest main twisted out of all of them. You can hear his footsteps when he's nearby. His footsteps sound like giant rocks hitting the ground. Twisted Pebble makes growling noises because he is a dog. His "ears" are actually his legs on his head. When he spots you, he will bark and start chasing you while making loud growling noises. He has a big sight range, which is really good because he can see you from far away. Toons with low stealth and bad speed have very low chances of surviving Twisted Pebble.

### 5) TWISTED VEE - Twisted Vee is the hardest main to encounter.

She is a TV that has been "infected" by Ichor. You can tell when she's on your floor from many different things. Before the elevator opens, you can hear her robotic footsteps. If you have memorized all the mains footsteps, you can easily tell that Twisted Vee is on your floor. Another way to tell is that once the elevator opens, advertisements pop up on your screen and you have to close them because they cover half of your screen. Sometimes the advertisements pop up while you're extracting a machine, which increases the chance of messing up the machine. No matter how far the machine is from Twisted Vee, she will run to it if you mess it up (this goes for all twisted mains.) When Twisted Vee sees you, she makes you move slower and it's hard to run away from her. The slowness will go away eventually but it appears again the longer Twisted Vee is chasing you.


