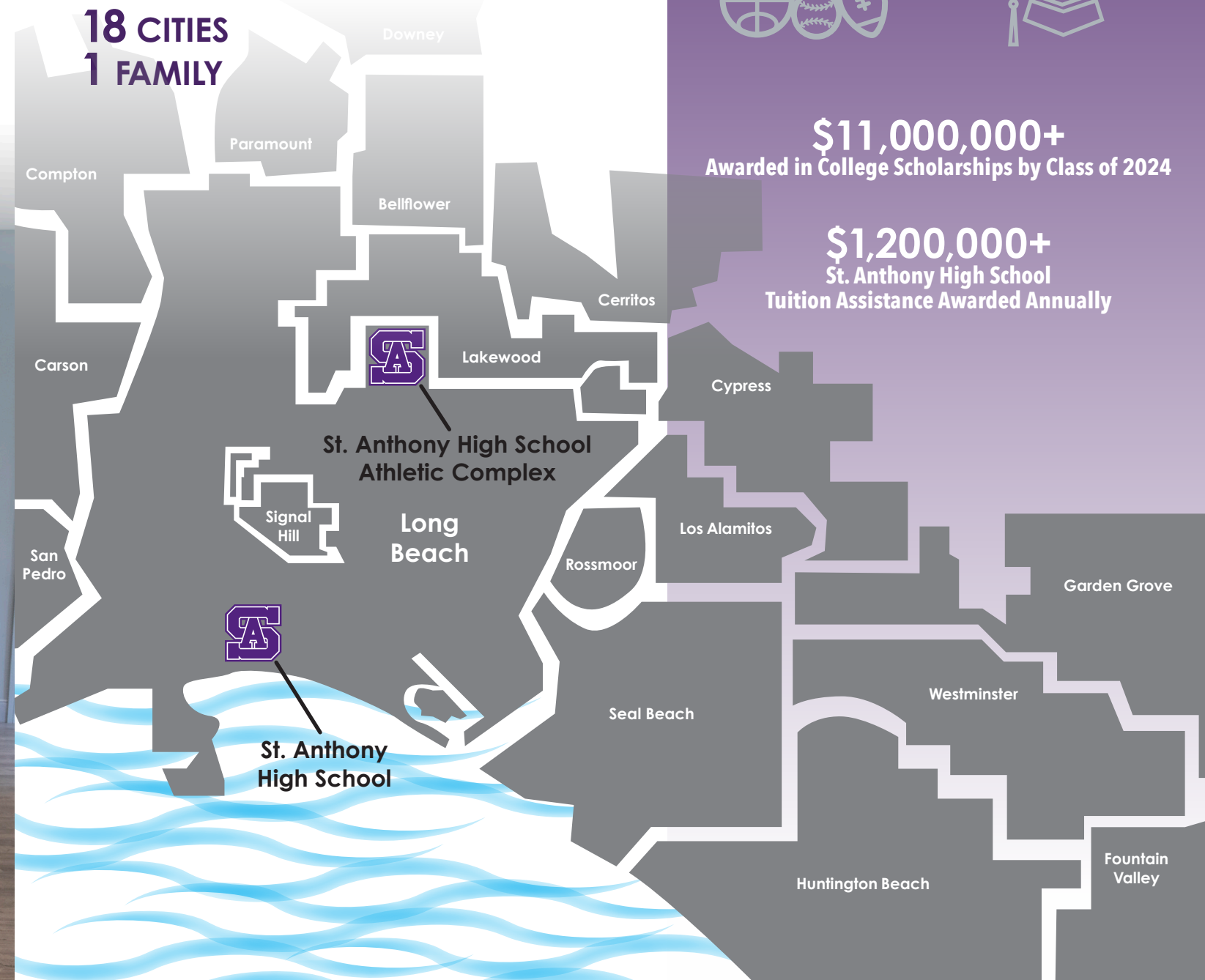

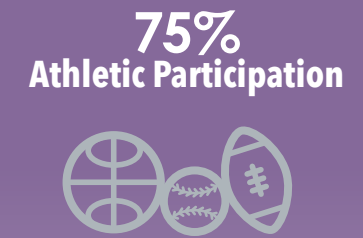

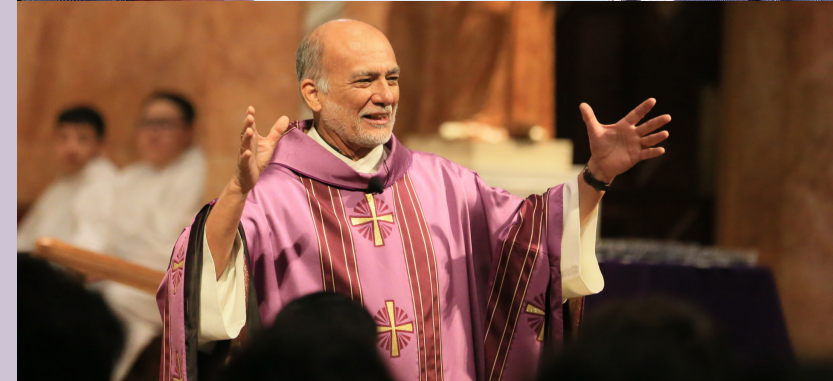
CHRISTIAN SERVICE

COLLEGE PREP CURRICULUM

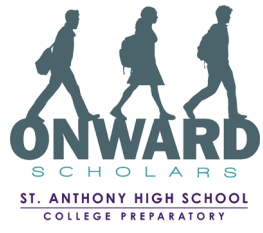
The College Preparatory Curriculum is designed to challenge each student. Upon graduation, SAHS students are prepared for admission to major universities across the United States. Teachers and counselors are readily available to assist students in preparing for college and life. Students select from a variety of CSU/UC-approved courses. 22 AP courses in 6 subject areas and nine honors courses in 5 subject areas are offered to qualified students seeking an even more rigorous program of study.

SAINT SCHOLAR PROGRAM

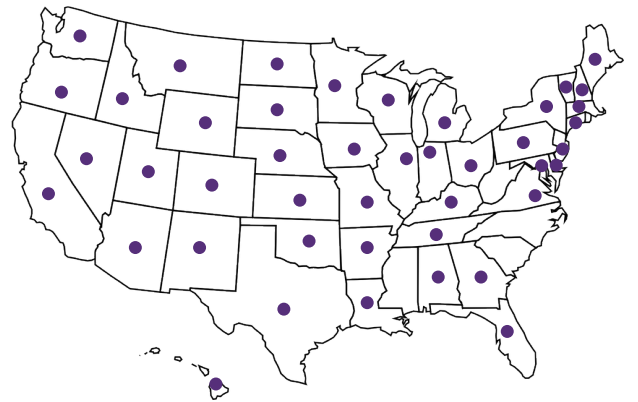
Being accepted as a Saints Scholar is a prestigious achievement for incoming freshmen at SAHS. Admission is highly competitive, reserved for students with exemplary citizenship, a minimum 3.7 GPA from 7th grade, and high standardized test scores. Once admitted, Saints Scholars enroll in honors-level classes tailored to their strengths. Completing a specified number of Honors/AP courses over four years earns recognition for their academic accomplishments.

ONWARD SCHOLARS PROGRAM

The Onward Scholars Program (OSP) is a competitive scholarship and enrichment program for selected students with strong academic and co-curricular backgrounds. OSP provides a unique four-year pathway to success for exceptional high school students who demonstrate academic excellence, impactful leadership, and motivation to dream big in their college search. The three main components of the Onward Scholars Program are scholarship, mentorship, and college access.
