

**Guidelines for Documentation for Alabama High School Diploma Using Alternate Requirements**  
**Alabama Administrative Code 290-4-2.02(1)e(2)e & 290-3-1-.02(8)(g)**

Requirement	Evidence
1. Completion of all course credits for the Alabama High School Diploma or the requirements for the Alabama Occupational Diploma	✓ Number of credits required in system
2. Documentation of the disability in the area of the <b>one</b> subject area test of the AHSGE that was not passed ( <b>Notice and Eligibility Decision Regarding Special Education Services</b> )	<p>✓ Area not passed and area of disability documented on <b>Notice and Eligibility Decision Regarding Special Education Services</b> must be the same</p> <p>⇒ <b>Examples</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student with an identified and documented disability in <b>reading</b> may be exempt from passing only the Reading portion of the AHSGE</li> <li>• Student with an identified and documented disability in <b>math</b> may be exempt from passing only the Math portion of the AHSGE</li> <li>• Student with an identified and documented disability in <b>written expression</b> may be exempt from passing <b>only</b> the Language portion of the AHSGE</li> </ul> <p>✓ Science and Social Studies are not considered areas for exemption based on the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Neither is an area of disability.</li> <li>• Science and Social Studies may be read aloud to student if the accommodation is determined appropriate and documented in IEP.</li> </ul> <p>✓ If student has disability in more than one identified and documented area, he may be exempt from any <b>one</b> area not passed on the AHSGE excluding Social Studies and Science.</p>
3. Participation in remediation activities during high school	<p>✓ Remediation may include but is not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Instruction based on IEP annual goals and benchmarks</li> <li>• Remedial courses in general education on Resource Room setting</li> <li>• Attempts at passing portion of AHSGE through 12<sup>th</sup> grade</li> </ul>
4. Met attendance requirements of the local school system	✓ See local attendance policy.
5. Hold a cumulative “C” grade average for all coursework (Grades 9-12)	✓ Review transcript.
