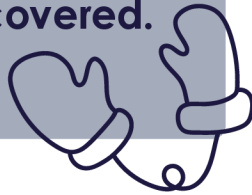


WINTER SAFETY TIPS

Get Organized

A planner is essential to keeping your child organized. Students should write down assignments and then review items in the planner both at the beginning and the end of the day to stay on track.

Know the Expectations

If expectations aren't clear on how students should turn in their work or how they will be graded, don't wait until a bad report card comes home. Your child should feel comfortable asking teachers questions about grading and assignments at any time. If this is not the case, it may be time for you as a parent to step in.

Designate a Study Area

Set your child up for success with a quiet, well-lit, low-traffic workspace. Make sure they have all the materials they need ready to go.

Develop a Study Plan

Students need to know when a test will take place, the types of questions that will be included, and the topics that will be covered. Assign topics and tasks for each day leading up to the due date or exam. Setting goals for each session is key to success!

Review Test-Taking Strategies

It is normal to feel stressed when taking an exam. However, there are strategies that will help your student manage the stress and do their best! Students should make sure to read all the directions on the exam and pace themselves so as not to feel rushed.
