

Winter Weather Clothing

 - ** Make sure to take your time. The online portion will not be complete if you rush through the process.
- 2) Complete the "Diocese of La Crosse Authorization and Acknowledgement of Criminal Background Check & Authorization for Release of FBI Information" form (Link to website PDF).
 - ** Under "CATHOLIC SCHOOLS", select "Other" and answer "Classroom Volunteer" or Field Trip Chaperone".
 - ** All blanks MUST be completed in order for the background check to be run. If you do not have a completed background check, you will not be able to volunteer.
