To gather the necessary data, they used tools like compasses, rulers, and protractors, as well as apps that measured distances and angles.



ATHLETIC CORNER

Tips & Advice with Dr. Nicole Kemper

Rest & Recovery for Athletes

There are so many benefits to rest and stretching during athletics and sport participation, and we are at a time of the year during Christmas break where our athletes can take the time to focus on both of these.

Resting for athletes includes both physiological and psychological benefits. Resting can promote muscle recovery, allowing time for glycogen to replenish itself in the body. It also promotes relaxation, prevents overtraining, and can even assist overcoming adaptation before those adaptations lead to too much stress and cause injury.

Rest days should include both passive and active recovery. Passive recovery involving taking the day off entirely from exercise or activity, and active recovery allowing lowintensity exercise. Active recovery also allows the body to repair soft tissue with blood circulation via stretching, walking, yoga, etc. Another important key concept during rest days is sleep, especially following exams and long weeks of practices and games.

Lastly, when we talk about stretching, it is important to note that stretching must last more than 15 seconds, at a minimum. We need to allow the physiological process of golgi tendon organs to override the muscle spindles to truly get stretching done at our muscles. A go to for this is holding all stretches for 30 seconds, overcoming the muscle spindles, and then feeling the stretch for an additional 15 seconds. This means to time your stretches instead of counting out loud to insure the stretch is beneficial.


