HFIS

- Replacement of the entire heating system, including new BMS, new boilers and adding air conditioning throughout the building
- Replacement of the roof of the building
- Reconstruction of the main parking lot, including the replacement of the drainage system.

JIO

- Replacement of the heating system, including new BMS, new boilers, and adding air conditioning throughout the building
- Replacement of the roof of the building
- Upgrades to the electrical system
- Renovation of the kitchen including new equipment and upgrades to the plumbing system.





HFIS and JIO Roof Project




- Work began over the summer and commenced in late November.
- Roofing company will be back in July/August of 2025 to complete the project after HVAC units are installed at both buildings.

Scope of Work: FMES



The list of work at the FMES is fairly extensive:

- Replacing all older electrical panels
- Replacing hot water pumps, air separator, and accessories
- Replacing the entire HVAC System, adding AC and updating the Building Management System (BMS)
- Upgrading a number of toilet rooms
- Adding a new elevator, as well as a ramp inside the building for accessibility
- Creating a new secure office and entryway
- Providing ADA access to the building at the front entrance
- Providing additional parking (18-20 spots) to ease parking congestion
- Repaving of the existing parking lot and bus loop
- Upgrades to the electrical system
- Construction of a new multipurpose room (Gymnasium/Cafeteria) with a warming kitchen
- Renovation of existing gym into learning spaces for Art/Music and a Library Media Center
- Renovation of existing kitchen and storage into a new Nurse's office










Roofing and ADA Compliant Front Entrance





Next Steps



- As of 12/18/24, FMES is on schedule to open in August of 2025.
- Continue pouring concrete for addition, with steel coming in early January.
- Looking to enclose new addition by mid-February.
- Complete ductwork on first floor by early January. 2nd floor is complete
- Continue working on all interior renovations including nurses space, "man trap", 3 new classrooms, bathrooms, etc...
- February 6, 2025 Architect and Construction Management Team will debrief the community at BOE Meeting.
- Phase III was just approved by SED: Kitchen renovations at JIO and HVAC for HFIS and JIO.
