It offers funding for college tuition, books, other educational expenses, and potential career opportunities in the Army.

### Who Can Apply?

- **Eligibility Criteria:**
  - U.S. citizenship.
  - High school junior or senior.
  - Minimum GPA of 2.5.
  - Age between 17 and 26.
  - No felony convictions.
  - Good physical and mental health.

#### 1. Research and Preparation:

- Prepare your academic transcripts, Physical Fitness Assessment (PFA), and any required personal statements.

#### 2. Application Process:

- Complete the online application form available on the Army Scholarship website.
- Submit all required documents by the deadline.

#### 3. Selection and Award:

- Applicants are evaluated based on academic performance, leadership potential, and personal achievements.
- Successful candidates will be notified and receive further instructions.

### Important Dates:

**Round 01** Due October 14, 2024 - Applications will be reviewed from October 21 – 25, 2024.

**Round 02** Due January 20, 2025 - Applications will be reviewed from January 27 – 31, 2025.

**Round 03** Due March 17, 2025 - Applications will be reviewed from March 24 – 28, 2025.
