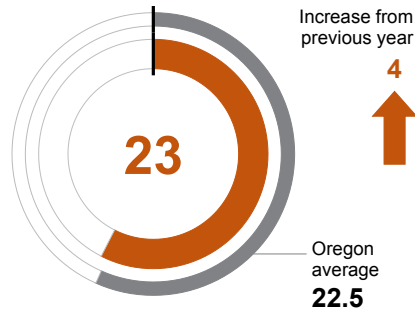

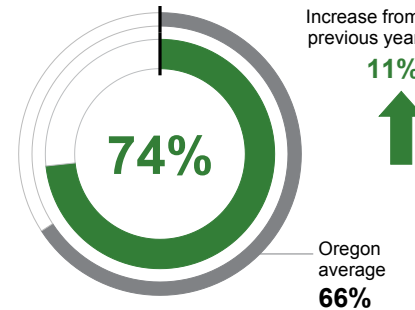

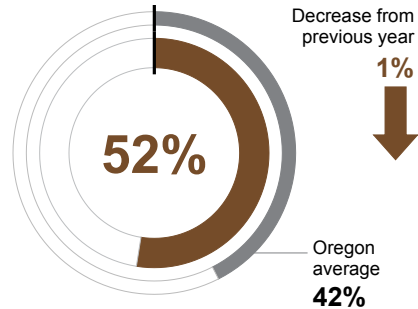

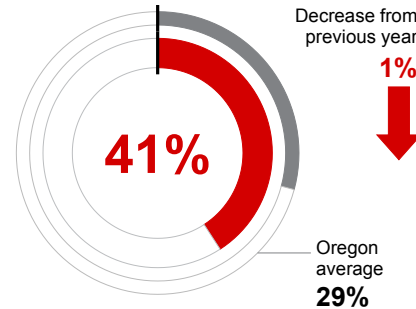

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



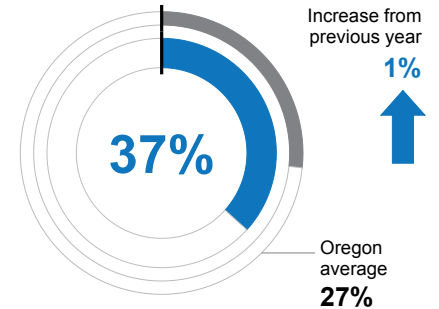
MATHEMATICS

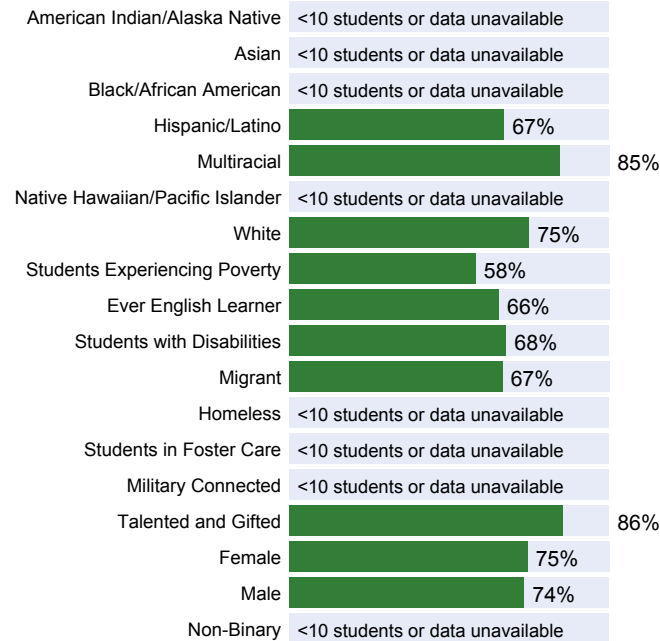

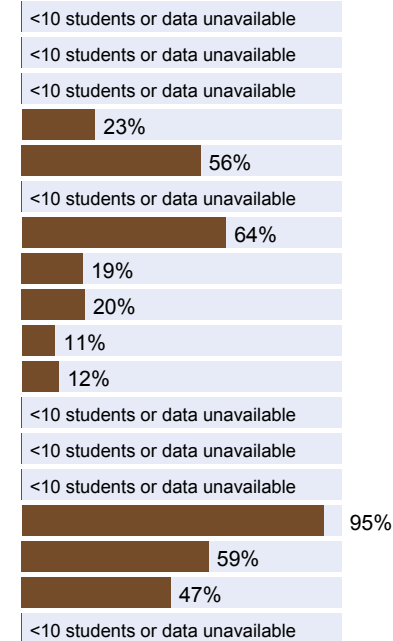

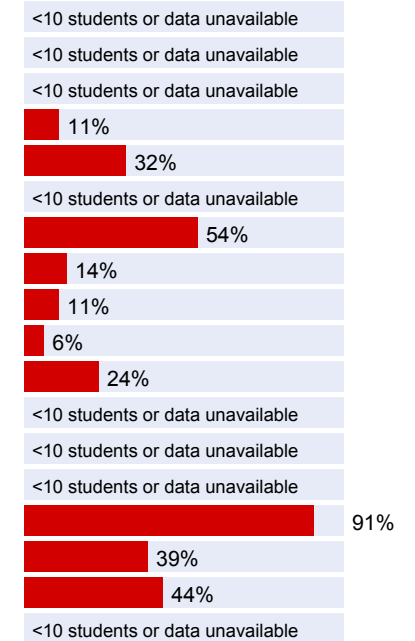

### About Our School

#### BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES
