<u>Brigance Early Childhood Kindergarten Screen</u>	K	Early Childhood Readiness	Beginning of Kindergarten	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● KDE requires all Kindergarteners to be screened ● Assessment of a child's development in five areas: Academic/Cognitive, Language Development, Physical Development, Self-Help and Social-Emotional Development ● Assessment is based upon the <u>Kentucky Early Childhood Standards</u>
<u>Formative Assessments</u>	K-6	All core subjects	Daily	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Informs instruction ● Anticipates and recognizes misconceptions in children's thinking ● Suggests how to use observations of students' work to effectively adapt instruction ● Highlights specific tasks that teachers can use to monitor children's progress toward mastery of <u>Kentucky Academic Standards</u> ● Common assessments derived from the instructional program or teacher created
<u>Summative Assessments</u>	K-6	All core subjects	At the end of each instructional unit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Assesses mastery of <u>Kentucky Academic Standards</u> ● Identify concepts for intervention ● Common assessments derived from the instructional program or teacher created

<u>STAR Assessments</u>	Pre-K - 6	Reading & Math	3 times per year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Criterion and Norm Referenced ● Diagnostic <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ (SB1 requires the primary (K-3) to use a diagnostic assessment to measure readiness in reading and math skills.) ● Plan instruction based upon the specific needs of individual students ● Track progress of individual students ● Provide academic feedback to students and parents ● Monitor students' mastery of academic standards/skills ● Used as the Universal Screener for grades K-3 for the Ky Reads to Succeed Act (SB9)
<u>MAP Growth</u>	3-6	Science	3 times per year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Criterion and Norm Referenced ● Plan instruction based upon the specific needs of individual students ● Track progress of individual students ● Provide academic feedback to students and parents
<u>KSA</u>	3-6	All core subjects <i>*Assessed in different grade levels. See the website for more information.</i>	Annually <i>*Last 14 Instructional Days of a district's calendar.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● KSA is the annual KDE required assessments given in grades 3-8, 10-11 to all Kentucky public school students. ● These assessments are Kentucky's measure of student proficiency and progress on the state content standards. These standards establish goals for what all students should know and be able to do in each grade.
<u>ACCESS for ELLs</u>	K-6	English Learners	Once Yearly	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students demonstrate their English language proficiency in all four language domains <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Listening ○ Speaking ○ Reading ○ Writing
