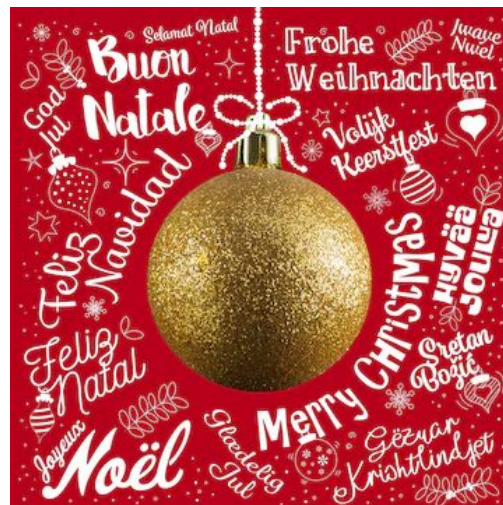
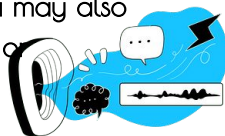


## Food Drive for Hunger
