### 2018-2019 DISTRICTWIDE ACHIEVEMENTS

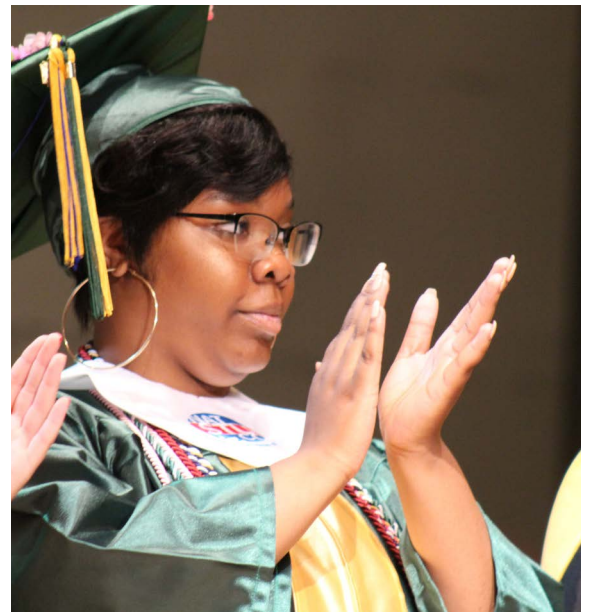
- Statewide ELA Assessments for grades 3-8 rose more than 10 percent

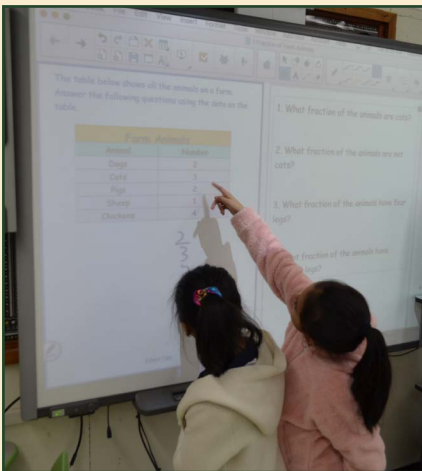

## On the Road to Success

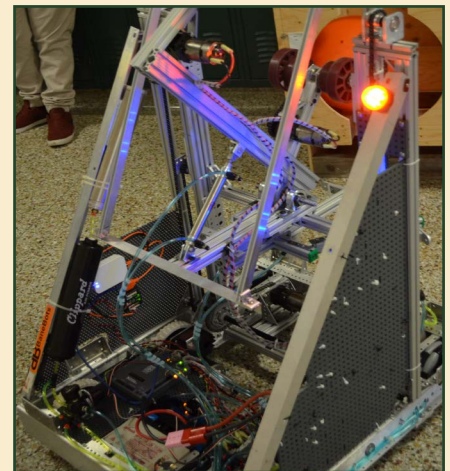
