

Weather Emergency Information

Council Rock monitors weather and/or travel-related conditions that might affect the safety of our students, and the school day. Our primary focus is always the safety of our students and staff, and keeping you informed on any changes that may occur.



Check that your Home Access Center information is up-to-date to receive email, phone, and/or text notifications from CRSD.

DELAYED OPENING / SCHOOL CLOSURES



- Notification of delayed openings/closures typically occur by 5:30 AM through the sources above.
- When schools are closed due to weather, **all evening community activities** scheduled in school buildings are also canceled.
- 2-hour delays adjust school start times as follows:
 - **High School** delayed start time: **9:30 AM**
 - **Middle School** delayed start time: **10:00 AM**
 - **Elementary School** delayed start time: **11:00 AM**
 - **Kindergarten:** AM/PM wait to hear from your child's school
- **Champions**
 - School closed: Champions program is cancelled.
 - 2-hr delay: Champions before-school opens at 8:00 AM.
- **MBIT**
 - CR Schools closed: MBIT students do not report to MBIT.
 - 2 hour MBIT delay: AM MBIT students should take their normal transportation to their high school.

EARLY DISMISSAL



- Early dismissal notifications are shared through the following:
 - Email from school and/or CRSD
 - Phone/Text Notification
 - Social Media Posts
 - Website Alert
- Be alert for weather-related changes and create a plan if a student is dismissed early and no one is at home.
- Early closing dismissal starts with the high schools, followed by middle schools, then elementary schools.
- Parent pick-ups increase in inclement weather. Plan extra travel time, be patient while waiting, and be cautious when driving to, from, and around school facilities.



IMPORTANT TIPS



- Set your device to receive notifications and alerts from CRSD.
- Be weather aware and check district websites frequently.
- Student safety while traveling is our primary objective and CR covers a large area of roadways and multiple municipalities. Please be patient for late or delayed buses due to hazardous conditions or uncleared roads.
- **PLAN AHEAD!** Discuss a plan for your child(ren) in the event of an early dismissal and no one is home when they arrive.
- Create a “snow chain” of families and caregivers to stay informed!
