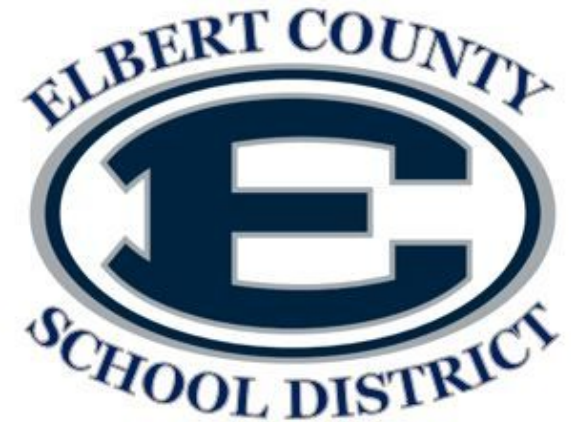

GOAL AREA I:

Teaching *and* Learning for All

1. Increase percentage of students scoring proficient or above on Georgia Milestones.
2. Increase CCRPI scores to meet or exceed state averages.
3. Maintain a 90% or higher graduation rate.
4. Improve critical analysis and problem solving through STEAM.
5. Maintain and develop new partnerships between Career, Technical, and Agricultural (CTAE) programs, Athens Technical College (ATC), and local businesses/ industries to provide high quality education and training programs.
6. Improve student support systems to meet the students' academic, emotional, and social needs.
