In order to qualify you must do the following:

# Submit your:

- Completed application
- Official high school transcript
- •SAT scores
- At least 3 letters of recommendation
- •Letter of acceptance

All items above must be submitted by Monday, April 28, 2025 to the 12th grade counselor, or mailed to:

# **General Information:**

- •Students must be a graduate from a Pontiac High School of the Pontiac Public School District.
- •At least three letters of recommendations from a school faculty/staff and one from the community must accompany all applications submitted.
- •AII correspondence must be typewritten.
- •An official high school transcript must be submitted-
- •There are fifteen (15) scholarships available for 2023 unless other funds become available.

## Criteria:

- "Must be a current high school senior
- ·Minimum high school cumulative G.P.A. at least a 2.5.
- ·Must be a 2023 graduate from a High School of the Pontiac Public School District.
- Must complete 10 questions included in application.
- $\cdot$ Must write a 350-500 word essay on "What Continuing Education means to me."

### **Award Amount:**

- •The award amounts will vary depending upon the type of scholarship awards granted. The maximum will be in the amount of \$3,000 per year. All scholarship awards can be applied to any accredited community college, college, university, or trade school.
- •Maximum award is for tuition and registration fees.
- •Maximum book allowance covers fall, winter, spring, and summer semesters.
