TEST ORDERING AND PAYMENT

Order by November 1, 2024

Payment due November 8, 2024

Ordering Procedure

1. Students [create a College Board account](#). Students who have previously taken AP exams will continue to use the same account. Only one account is needed for all AP exams a student will take. Student College Board accounts will be set up during class time.
2. Students will join the AP classroom with a specific code provided by their AP teacher in class. ALL AP students will join AP classrooms for all AP courses they are enrolled in regardless of their intention to test.
3. **By November 1** - In their College Board account, students must decide and **select Yes or No** to take the exam for each of their AP courses.
4. Starting November 6 - Students may pay for their AP exams. See specific instructions on the next page.
5. **By November 8** - Students must pay all AP exam fees.
 - a. No AP exams will be ordered for students who have not paid by November 8.

AP Exam Fees and payment

- **One Free AP Exam!**
 - The School District of Onalaska will pay for ONE AP exam for every student at OHS. This ONE free exam can only be used ONCE during a student's years at OHS. If you took an exam for free in a previous year, you will NOT receive a second free one this year.
- Students must pay for all other exams beyond the ONE free AP exam.
- Every AP exam a student plans to take each year (whether paid for by the district, or the student) must still be ordered through your College Board account.
- The cost for every AP exam beyond ONE free AP exam is \$99.00.
- There is no cost for students who are eligible to receive free or reduced lunch. See or email your counselor if you have questions.

Additional AP exam Fees

- \$40 fee for canceling an AP exam after the official registration deadline (EG: student pays \$99 for exam but cancels or does not take their exam. Student will be reimbursed \$58. (\$99 - \$40 = \$58 refund)
- \$40 late registration fee for signing up for an AP exam AFTER the AP ordering deadline.
- Students with multiple tests on the same day MAY choose to pay an extra \$40 to test at an alternate date.
- Students may register for tests that are not listed at OHS. Contact Student Services to register/pay.

Pay by Check -- Due to Student Services Office by November 8, 2024

Make one check payable to "OHS" for the amount owed (see payment guide below)

Bring your check to Mrs. de Boer in the Student Services Office no later than November 8

Payment Guide -- Please remember that if you took an AP Exam in the past 4 years, you have already used your one free exam from the school district. Additional exams are \$99 each.

Pay Via Your PowerSchool Account

1. Log into your Parent PowerSchool account
2. Click on the arrow at the top right of your screen to locate your applications
3. Select SchoolPay from the slideout menu
4. The first time you access SchoolPay through PowerSchool, you will be asked if you're brand new or have an existing account.

Create an Account or Login to SchoolPay

1. Go to www.schoolpay.com
2. If you don't have an account, click "Create an Account"
3. If you have an account, fill out the form to Login
4. Complete the quick 3-step registration form

*Note this online payment option will not be available until November 5, 2024. If you cannot wait until November 5th to pay, you can send in 1 check with the total amount. Remember one test is paid for by the District.

Please have payments for all AP tests made by November 8, 2024 – either online or to the Student Services Office.

If you need financial assistance there is help available; please see your counselor. All students who qualify for the free/reduced lunch program do not pay AP fees.

How are AP tests set up and graded?

Typically:

- ½ of the test is multiple choice, graded by computer. There is no penalty for guessing!
- ½ of the test is free-response (essay). Questions are graded by individual consultants.
- AP Tests are given a score of 1-5. Here is a typical breakdown of how schools consider awarding college credit:
 - 1=Not recommended for credit
 - 2=Possibly qualified for credit
 - 3=Qualified for credit
 - 4=Well qualified for credit
 - 5=Extremely well qualified for credit
- Each college sets its own standard as to what grade it will accept for the purpose of giving credit.
