#### At Mt. Caesar:


- Crews reached the goal of making Building A mostly airtight. This allows significant interior work to begin during the holiday break.
- Installation of roof insulation and membrane are well underway.
   Concrete preparation and pouring Is ongoing.
- The remaining lower roofs should be complete in early January.

- Framing of the administration wing will begin after the new year.
