1/7 – 1/21: Teachers enter recommendations and lock them into students’ course requests

1/8: Students receive Course Selection Guides in homeroom

1/8 at 6:30 PM: Counselors host scheduling presentation for parents

1/13 – 1/16: HS Community Period presentations / Recordings will be made available for 8th grade students

1/22 – 1/23: 8th grade students enter course requests in StudentVUE

1/24 – 1/27: 9th & 10th grade students enter course requests in StudentVUE

1/28 – 1/29: 11th grade students enter course requests in StudentVUE

2/7 – 2/13: Student Course Request Verifications uploaded into StudentVUE / ParentVUE for students & parents to review / Students/parents may make changes to the requests that were submitted

Mid-May: Completed student schedules for the 2025-2026 school year available in StudentVUE/ParentVUE

June 1 – August 1: **Final opportunity to submit course request changes for the 2025-2026 school year**
