



Parent Guide: Infinite Campus

Updated: January 2025

Overview:

Infinite Campus Parent provides a view of a student's up-to-date attendance, schedule, grades, assessments, and more. Guardians can access this tool through the Infinite Campus Parent app on a mobile device, or through the Infinite Campus Parent website. Guardians use their district-provided username and password to login. Students login to *Infinite Campus Student* separately with their own district-provided credentials.

Infinite Campus through the Mobile App:

1. Search for the *Infinite Campus Parent* app and install it on your mobile device.
2. To log in for the first time, input Worthington for the district name, select Ohio, and click Search.
3. On the next screen, input the district-provided guardian username and password. If you do not know these login credentials, retrieve them through the [Password Recovery Link](#). We recommend clicking the box that says *Stay logged in* to receive push notifications.




NOTE: If you have an older version of the Infinite Campus Parent app installed on your mobile device, and are getting an error message that it cannot connect, delete the app from your device and re-install it, then follow the steps above.

Infinite Campus through their website:

1. Go to the Worthington Schools Infinite Campus Parent website at <https://worthingtonoh.infinitecampus.org/campus/portal/parents/worthington.jsp>
2. Input district-provided guardian username and password to log in. If you do not know these login credentials, retrieve them through the [Password Recovery Link](#).

Navigating Infinite Campus:

The home page shows your student(s) and a count of recent updates to their grades, attendance and assignments. Click the student name to expand this information. Click the gear icon to adjust the timeframe for these updates.



Click the three horizontal lines in the top left to see the menu:

Calendar shows assignments, schedule and attendance by date. *For families with multiple children, toggle on the top right to select which child to view.*

Grades displays grades for each course. Select term or quarter on top of page.

Attendance shows all absences and tardies. Click on course name to open a more detailed view.

Documents allows you to print a report card or transcript (for high school students). To print an elementary progress report, click on K-3 or 4-5 Progress Report.

Message Center shows communications from school buildings, and updates to grades and attendance.

More shows a full list of student assessment scores.

Setting **Notification Preferences** allows you to be notified immediately as attendance events and grades are recorded. To set your notification preferences, click the person icon in the top right corner. Select Settings. Select Notification Settings. Use the sliding scale and boxes to select notification preferences. Click the blue Save button.



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Notification Settings

These settings are applied to in-app notifications and mobile push notifications. Mobile users must mark "Stay logged in" when logging in to receive mobile push notifications.

Select notifications to receive. Notifications are deleted after 30 days.

Assignment is scored

Less than 70%  A horizontal sliding scale with a blue dot positioned at approximately 70%.

Grade is updated

Less than 80%  A horizontal sliding scale with a blue dot positioned at approximately 80%.

Attendance is updated
