Six different full-time, four-year <u>Career Academies</u> welcome students as freshmen and combine rigorous academics with research and field experiences to give students a significant head start on their college and career journeys. A range of <u>Shared Time</u> career programs engage high school juniors and seniors in a career area of interest for half a day, and they remain in their home high school for core courses. The <u>Career Center</u> introduces students with special needs in grades 9-12 to different vocations before they select one for focused training. <u>Adult Education</u> programming gives adult and postsecondary students affordable options for career training to enter the workforce, advance in their current careers or pursue a new one.
