Enrollment Options

All families pick the days they need care when registering. Families have the ability to adjust their schedules (add or remove days) through May 12 by emailing kidsclub@isd12.org. As of May 13, schedules are locked and you will be billed for the days that you are registered. For additional days, if space allows, families can request drop-in care at the rate of \$70/day. Drop-in care is only available when space allows. There will be no refunds for missed days.

18-24 (minimum required is 18)	\$59

Kids Club will provide optional care Aug. 18-21 at limited sites. These extra days do NOT count towards your pick-your-day number. More information regarding these days and registration will be available in June to those who are registered to attend this summer.

Daily Activities

Children are organized into groups by similar grade. Each room environment features age-appropriate centers with games, blocks and manipulatives, arts and crafts, social emotional learning, reading center and creative play area. Outdoor recreational experiences happen daily as well. Kids Club follows a curriculum called Character Strong to teach social emotional skills.

Most weeks, students will swim on Mondays at the Centennial Pool. Field trips will occur most weeks on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday. Fridays will have a variety of fun activities planned by sites. Please note, schedules are subject to change.
