Marple Newtown School District Demographic Study, Nov. 2021

Marple Township is a township in Delaware County, Pennsylvania. It contains the census designated place of Broomall. The population was 23,743 at 2015. ZIP codes include mainly 19008, but also partially 19064 and 19063.

The Delaware County area was first settled by Quakers who came to Pennsylvania by the Delaware River on September 29, 1683. The ship they used was called the Endeavor. Marple Township was originally settled in 1684 and was recognized as a township in the same year.

According to the United States Census Bureau, the township has a total area of 10.5 square miles, of which, 10.2 square miles of it is land and 0.3 square miles of it (2.95%) is water.

The community of Broomall is located in, but is not coterminous with, Marple Township—the township also includes part of the ZIP codes of Springfield and Media. Other villages include Larchmont (also in Newtown Township) and Lawrence Park. Waterways in Marple Township include Crum Creek, Darby Creek, Hotland Run, Springton Lake and Trout Run.

As of the census of 2020, there were 24,214 people, up slightly from 23,428 people in 2010. The 2000 census showed 8,623 households, and 6,415 families residing in the township. The population density was 2,326.1 people per square mile. There were 8,797 housing units at an average density of 862.1/sq mi.

The racial makeup of the township was 92.60% White, 1.10% African American, 0.09% Native American, 5.51% Asian, 0.12% from other races, and 0.59% from two or more races. Hispanic or Latino of any race were 0.66% of the population.

There were 8,623 households, out of which 30.0% had children under the age of 18 living with them, 64.1% were married couples living together, 7.6% had a female householder with no husband present, and 25.6% were non-families. 22.6% of all households were made up of individuals, and 13.0% had someone living alone who was 65 years of age or older. The average household size was 2.64 and the average family size was 3.12.

In the township the population was spread out, with 21.8% under the age of 18, 6.3% from 18 to 24, 24.8% from 25 to 44, 25.0% from 45 to 64, and 22.0% who were 65 years of age or older. The median age was 43 years. For every 100 females there were 89.4 males. For every 100 females age 18 and over, there were 85.1 males.

The median income for a household in the township was \$59,577, and the median income for a family was \$71,829. Males had a median income of \$47,062 versus \$32,304 for females. The per capita income for the township was \$28,494. About 2.1% of families and 4.6% of the population were below the poverty line, including 3.7% of those under age 18 and 5.0% of those age 65 or over.

Newtown Township is a township in Delaware County, Pennsylvania, United States. Prior to 1789 it was part of Chester County. The population was 12,216 as of the 2010 census.

At the turn of the 20th century, the automobile began to disperse the urban populations over the countryside. The trolleys, along with the new "horseless carriage," transformed the country farmers into suburban commuters. Farms were sold and the land subdivided. Newtown Square boomed. Many city dwellers retained their country estates, however, these became hidden amidst gridiron developments. Although construction slackened during the depression, another boom was experienced after World War II. Some farms and large estates remain, but for the most part, the township was developed into a suburban community with old stone homes and structures dotting the landscape to serve as reminders of days gone by.

According to the United States Census Bureau, the township has a total area of 10.1 square miles of which, 10.0 square miles of it is land and 0.1 square miles of it (0.69%) is water. Its villages include Echo Valley, Florida Park, Larchmont (also in Marple Township,) Newtown Square, and Wyola.

As of the census of 2020, there were 15,002 people, an increase from the 2010 population of 12,216. In 2010, there were 4,549 households, and 3,184 families residing in the township. The population density was 1,166.0 people per square mile. There were 4,690 housing units at an average density of 467.4 per square mile.

The racial makeup of the township was 96.16% White, 0.66% African American, 0.07% Native American, 2.30% Asian, 0.13% from other races, and 0.68% from two or more races. Hispanic or Latino of any race were 0.69% of the population.

There were 4,549 households, out of which 27.6% had children under the age of 18 living with them, 60.4% were married couples living together, 7.2% had a female householder with no husband present, and 30.0% were non-families. 27.2% of all households were made up of individuals, and 15.9% had someone living alone who was 65 years of age or older. The average household size was 2.50 and the average family size was 3.06.

In the township the population was spread out, with 23.1% under the age of 18, 4.9% from 18 to 24, 24.4% from 25 to 44, 25.6% from 45 to 64, and 21.9% who were 65 years of age or older. The median age was 43 years. For every 100 females there were 88.9 males. For every 100 females age 18 and over, there were 83.2 males.

The median income for a household in the township was \$65,924, and the median income for a family was \$82,557. Males had a median income of \$61,688 versus \$37,319 for females. The per capita income for the township was \$39,364. About 1.8% of families and 3.5% of the population were below the poverty line, including 2.6% of those under age 18 and The 10.1 square mile Newtown Township has a 2020 population of 15,,002 persons.

[CDT](#)- Classroom Diagnostic Tools (CDT) are based on content assessed by the Keystone Exams and the Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (PSSA). Although not a predictor for PSSA and Keystone Exam performance, CDTs provide a snapshot on why and how students may still be struggling or exceeding grade and/or course Eligible Content. The CDT data, along with other data, informs instruction in a timely and efficient manner.

Circulation is defined as the number of items borrowed from the library. Items may be loaned multiple times throughout the school year.

Current Titles is defined as the number of physical books available for loan from a library.

Every Pennsylvania student in grades 3 through 8 is assessed in English Language Arts and Math. Every Pennsylvania student in grades 4 and 8 is assessed in science.

[PVAAS](#)- Pennsylvania's Value-Added Assessment System. Value added is a statistical analysis used to measure a district's, school's or teacher's influence on the academic progress rates of groups of students from year to year.

[Real Estate Tax Rate](#)- rates assessed on the taxable value of real property in each school district.
