# STEPS TO COMPLETE THE FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA)

- Create a FSA ID number ([studentaid.gov/fsa-id](https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id))
  - You will use the FSA ID number to complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
  - **Parents of dependent students must also obtain a FSA ID.**
- For 2024-2025, apply for financial aid by submitting a FAFSA at [www.studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa](https://www.studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa) between December 2024 and March 2, 2025 to be considered for all available funds including Cal Grant, Middle Class Scholarship and State University Grant.
  - FAFSAs continue to be accepted throughout the academic year for remaining funds.
- Enter your name exactly as it appears on your Social Security card.
- If you are an eligible non-citizen, you must enter your Permanent Registration Number.
- The Direct Data Exchange (DDX) allows tax information to come directly from the IRS to the Department of Education. Students and parents must approve usage of the DDX to be eligible for federal financial aid. The 2024-2025 FAFSA uses 2022 tax information.
- View your FAFSA Submission Summary mailed or emailed to you. Verify information and make corrections if necessary.
